Brad Bowen reported that the Western Lakes Fire Department was the beneficiary of a donation that is supporting the launching of a drone program. They are also refurbishing the incident rehab vehicle.

Matt Redmann announced that he secured new employment with a firm in South Carolina and will relocate some time in 2022. The committee will need to elect a new Chair in 2021.
