1       MODIFY THE 2024 WORKFORCE AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FUND BUDGET  
2               TO ACCEPT THE EMPLOY MILWAUKEE SKILLS TO BUILD GRANT AND  
3                               APPROPRIATE EXPENDITURES  
4

5       WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Labor made additional funds available through the Building  
6       Pathways to Infrastructure Jobs Grant; and  
7

8       WHEREAS, Employ Milwaukee Workforce Development Board obtained a \$5 Million dollar  
9       grant from the U.S. Department of Labor to create employment and training activities for eligible  
10       individuals in certain advanced infrastructure careers, and offset some employer costs in  
11       providing training; and  
12

13       WHEREAS, the WOW Works Workforce Development Board has received a subgrantee award  
14       notice from the Employ Milwaukee Workforce Development Board in the amount of  
15       \$1,518,349; and  
16

17       WHEREAS, the grant funds of \$1,518,349 provide an opportunity for the WOW Works  
18       Workforce Development Board to fund contracted services and personnel costs to assist eligible  
19       individuals seeking employment in the advanced manufacturing field; and  
20

21       WHEREAS, Waukesha County, as the fiscal agent for the WOW Workforce Development  
22       Board, may accept the grant funds on behalf of the Waukesha, Ozaukee, Washington Workforce  
23       Development Board; and  
24

25       WHEREAS, \$1,366,514 of the grant funds will provide an opportunity for WOW Works to fund  
26       contracted incumbent worker training programs through Waukesha County Technical College  
27       and Moraine Park Technical College; and  
28

29       WHEREAS, the remaining \$151,835 of grant funds is for indirect cost reimbursements, which  
30       are already in the budget, and do not require additional appropriation.  
31

32       WHEREAS, the grant award requires a 15% match, which will mainly be covered with in-kind  
33       staff resources already included in the Department of Parks and Land Use budget; and  
34

35       WHEREAS, the Waukesha County Department of Parks and Land Use is proposing to amend  
36       the 2024 adopted budget by increasing expenditures by an additional \$1,366,514 to fund grant  
37       contracted services.


39       THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS  
40       that the Waukesha County Department of Parks and Land Use, through the Workforce  
41       Development Board Director, is authorized to enter into a grant agreement as fiscal agent for the  
42       WOW Works Workforce Development Board, subject to the approval of Corporation Counsel, to  
43       accept the Employ Milwaukee Workforce Development Board Skills to Build grant funds for  
44       workforce program services in Waukesha, Ozaukee, and Washington Counties in the amount of

FISCAL NOTE

MODIFY THE 2024 WORKFORCE AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FUND BUDGET  
TO ACCEPT THE EMPLOY MILWAUKEE SKILLS TO BUILD GRANT AND  
APPROPRIATE EXPENDITURES

This ordinance authorizes the county to accept the Employ Milwaukee Skills to Build Grant of \$1,518,349. The ordinance also modifies the 2024 Parks and Land Use – Workforce and Economic Development Fund budget to increase expenditure appropriations by \$1,366,514 to fund contracted incumbent worker training programs through Waukesha County Technical College and Moraine Park Technical College. The remaining \$151,835 of grant funds is reimbursement for estimated indirect costs at 10% of the total grant, which is already included in the budget and does not require additional appropriation. The department is requesting to appropriate the entire \$1,366,514 in the current year and plans to request carry over of unspent balances each year through the life of the grant, which ends on September 30, 2028. The grant requires an in-kind local match of 15% or \$227,752, which department management indicates will be provided through base budget resources, including staff time.

30 Town Board of the Town of Genesee or unless otherwise expressly authorized by law.

- 32 2. Soil borings shall be conducted on Outlot 5 to ensure a suitable area is available for an  
33 on-site septic system approved by Waukesha County Environmental Health Division.

- 35 3. The owner of Outlot 5 shall have an undivided fractional ownership in all of the outlots in  
36 Fields Crossing Subdivision, same as the other lot owners within the Fields Crossing  
37 Subdivision.

- 39 4. The proposed development of Outlot 5 shall comply with all requirements of the  
40 Declaration of Restrictions for Fields Crossing Subdivision.







**LOCATION:**  
Outlot 5, Fields Crossing, part of the NE ¼ of the SE ¼ of Section 34, T6N, R18E, Town of Genesee. More specifically, the property is located on the southwest corner of STH 83 and Fields Crossing Drive containing approximately 2.58 acres.

**EXISTING ZONING:**  
A-2 Rural Home District (Town).

**PROPOSED ZONING:**  
A-3 Suburban Estate District (Town).

**EXISTING LAND USE:**  
Vacant

**PROPOSED LAND USE:**  
Single family residential development.

**PUBLIC HEARING DATE:**  
September 25, 2023

**PUBLIC REACTION:**  
Don Murn spoke on the reasons for rezone so they can sell it for a single-family home. He states that it doesn't sit in an area that would affect any roads or stormwater management.

Chad Bartkowki, S60W30157 Fields Crossing Dr, stated that when they bought their parcel of land, it was stated that Outlot number 5 would remain an Outlot and green space. That this was one of the reasons that they bought the lot they did.

Don Murn then rebutted stating that he is not sure what the broker for the land told people, but that per the Plat of Subdivision, Outlot 5 is owned by the developer and that it can be developed further per developer rights. He feels for the residents if it was misrepresented but that they were never told that by himself or his father.

Gabe Winzeried, S60W30110 Fields Crossing Dr, stated that the Kings Way broker misrepresented the outlot saying it would remain an Outlot.

Diane Gue1Tero, S59W30128 Jumpers Circle states that this outlot is not dividable and that she has a deeded fractional ownership of this lot.

Lani Bartkowki, S60W30157 Fields Crossing Dr, stated that they were told by the Kings Way broker that it would remain an Outlot. She also questioned when an HOA would take power in the subdivision and not the developer.

Joel Anders, S59W30287 Fields Crossing stated that they were also told that this would remain an Outlot and that he believes it should remain greenspace.

Connie Kukuwich, S60W30201 Fields Crossing Dr, stated that she was also told it would remain an Outlot. She states she has a deed which grants her fractional ownership of said lot.

Katie Graf, W303S6074 Bridle Lane, stated that she was also told that at the time of purchase of her lot, she was told that this would remain an Outlot.

Don Murn stated that again, in the Plat of Subdivision, this Outlot is not a part of the deeded fractional ownership.

Diane GuelTero, S59W30128 Jumpers Circle, proceeded to read a portion of her deeded fractional ownership and it was determined that Outlot 5 is not one of these with deeded partial ownership.

**TOWN PLAN COMMISSION:**

On October 25, 2023, the Town Plan Commission unanimously recommended approval of the rezoning request to the Town Board subject to conditions.

**TOWN BOARD ACTION:**

On November 13, 2023, the Town Board unanimously approved the rezoning request subject to conditions.

**COMPLIANCE WITH THE WAUKESHA COUNTY DEVELOPMENT PLAN (CDP) AND THE TOWN OF GENESEE LAND USE PLAN (LUP):**

The Town and County CDP's designate the subject parcel as Rural Density and Other Agricultural Land (5 acres/dwelling unit). The land use plan categories for the subdivision are Rural Density and Other Agricultural Land and Primary Environmental Corridor, both of which are 5 acres per dwelling unit. The subdivision contains 121.4 acres of land, yielding a maximum density of 24 dwelling units. Only 17 residential lots have been platted. Therefore, the rezone complies with both plans.

**STAFF ANALYSIS:**

Fields Crossing subdivision was platted in 2009, prior to the reconstruction of State Highway 83. The subject property, Outlot 5 of Fields Crossing, is 2.58 acres and is located south of Fields Crossing Drive at the entrance to the subdivision. The property abuts a roundabout that intersects S.T.H. 83, C.T.H. X and Fields Crossing Drive. The subdivision has 17 platted lots that are zoned A-2 Rural Home District, requiring a minimum 3-acre lot size. The lands to the north and south of the subdivision are also zoned A-2 District. There are smaller lots east of S.T.H. 83 zoned R-1 Residential District.

Fields Crossing is unique in that the plat planned for the reconstruction of S.T.H. 83 by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation. The subdivision entrance was to be relocated south to connect to the roundabout constructed by the State. The plat contains numerous notes that dictate the future road dedications, possible lot combinations and easements necessary to complete the project. A temporary limited easement granted to the Wisconsin Department of Transportation encompassed much of Outlot 5 to allow the DOT the ability to reconstruct and restore Fields Crossing Drive where it intersects S.T.H. 83. The need for this easement would have prohibited the lot's development as a residential lot at the time.

The subdivision plat notes that the developer was to retain Outlot 5 along with two other outlots. It states, "Outlots 4, 5 and 12 shall be owned by the developer and may be combined with abutting lands or reconfigured as buildable lots in the future." Portions of Outlots 4 and 12 were necessary for the road realignment. In 2014, following completion of the project, the remnants of those outlots were combined with Lot 16 and replatted as two residential lots. Outlot 5, however, does not have the ability to be reconfigured or combined with abutting lands to achieve the A-2 District's minimum lot size requirement of three acres. Two single family residential



homes exist directly south and west of the property and roadways abut the property to the north and east. Therefore, the developer is seeking to rezone the property to the A-3 Suburban Estate District, which only requires a 2-acre minimum lot size, so that the property may be utilized for single family residential development.

The proposed zoning change to a different residential zoning district does not afford a change in the use of the property. The use of the property will still be residential with similar setbacks and offsets as the adjacent properties. The outlot was not used for open space calculations when developing the subdivision and does not contain stormwater management practices or natural resources. Finally, the zoning being proposed is consistent with the Town of Genesee and Waukesha County Land Use Plans.


**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

Based on the above analysis, the Planning and Zoning Division Staff recommends **approval** of the rezone request, subject to the following conditions imposed by the Town:

1. Outlot 5 shall never be further divided absent the express written approval of the Town Board of the Town of Genesee. No new lots or outlots shall be created absent the express written approval of the Town Board of the Town of Genesee. No lot line or outlot line shall be adjusted or reconfigured in any way absent the express written approval of the Town Board of the Town of Genesee or unless otherwise expressly authorized by law.
2. Soil borings shall be conducted on Outlot 5 to ensure a suitable area is available for an on-site septic system approved by Waukesha County Environmental Health Division.
3. The owner of Outlot 5 shall have an undivided fractional ownership in all of the Outlots in Fields Crossing Subdivision, same as the other lot owners within the Fields Crossing Subdivision.
4. The proposed development of Outlot 5 shall comply with all requirements of the Declaration of Restrictions for Fields Crossing Subdivision.

The proposal is consistent with Town and County plan recommendations. The notes on the plat indicate Outlot 5 may be developed as a residential lot in the future. The rezone will place the property in a zone that is more compatible with its size and allow the developer to market the property for single family residential purposes, consistent with the surrounding area.

**ORDINANCE 23-5**

**An Ordinance to amend the Zoning Map of the Town of Genesee  
from A-2 Rural Home District to A-3 Suburban Estate District on lands located in the  
SE ¼ of Section 34, T6N, R18E, Town of Genesee,  
Waukesha County Wisconsin**

The Town Board of Genesee, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1:**

The Town of Genesee Zoning Map is hereby amended to change the zoning classification from A-2 Rural Home District A-3 Suburban Estate District on the following described parcel of land:

Outlot 5 Fields Crossing, being a part of the SE ¼ of Section 34, T6N, R18E, Town of Genesee. More specifically, the property is also known as Tax Key No. GNT 1576.021.

Subject to the following conditions:

1. Outlot 5 shall never be further divided absent the express written approval of the Town Board of the Town of Genesee. No new lots or outlots shall be created absent the express written approval of the Town Board of the Town of Genesee. No lot line or outlot line shall be adjusted or reconfigured in any way absent the express written approval of the Town Board of the Town of Genesee or unless otherwise expressly authorized by law.
2. Soil borings shall be conducted on Outlot 5 to ensure a suitable area is available for an on-site septic system approved by Waukesha County Environmental Health Division.
3. The owner of Outlot 5 shall have an undivided fractional ownership in all of the Outlots (Outlots 6, 9, 10 & 11) in Fields Crossing Subdivision, same as the other lot owners within the Fields Crossing Subdivision.
4. The proposed development of Outlot 5 shall comply with all requirements of the Declaration of Restrictions for Fields Crossing Subdivision.

**Section 2: Severability.**

The several sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

**PUBLIC REACTION:**  
Marleene Bloom, W305S5035 Homestead Ct., states that she is worried about it becoming a junk yard if they are fixing trucks. She also worries that there may be noise from the operation. She verified that there will be no access from STH 59 to this new business.

Mr. Bendler states that this is his business, and he wants to keep it clean. He also states that most newer diesel engines are as quiet as gasoline engines. He states that what he works on will be no louder than the vehicles that travel on STH 59. He also stated that he does not work on larger vehicles such as dump trucks.

**TOWN PLAN COMMISSION:**  
On October 25, 2023, the Town Plan Commission unanimously recommended approval of the rezoning request.

**TOWN BOARD ACTION:**

On November 13, 2023, the Town Board unanimously approved the rezoning request.

**COMPLIANCE WITH THE WAUKESHA COUNTY DEVELOPMENT PLAN (CDP) AND THE TOWN OF GENESEE LAND USE PLAN (LUP):**

The Town of Genesee Land Use Plan designates the subject parcel in the Commercial category and the County CDP designates the subject parcel in the Commercial and Office Park category. The proposed rezone will comply with both plans.

**STAFF ANALYSIS:**

The subject parcel contains approximately 2.78 acres of land and has approximately 204 feet of frontage on Commercial Drive. The parcel is in the Genesee business area which has a mixture of B-2 Local Business District and B-3 General Business District zoning. The lands immediately adjacent to the west and north are zoned B-3 General Business District. Other businesses on the street include a swimming pool supply store, professional offices, a funeral home and Sidelines Pub and Grill. Commercial Drive has a sixty-six (66) foot wide right-of-way and a physical road width of approximately twenty-five (25) feet. There is a residentially zoned area to the south across STH 59 with single family homes with frontage off Old Village Road. The subject property contains no wetlands or environmental corridors.

The petitioner is proposing to rezone the currently vacant parcel from the B-2 Local Business District to the B-3 General Business District under the Town of Genesee Zoning Code. The reason for the request is to accommodate the development of an automotive sales and repair business, which is not a permitted use under the current zoning. According to the Town Planner's report, the main operation would be auto (diesel) repair and service with the sales of approximately ten (10) cars/trucks per year. The report also noted that a new auto repair business was approved for the property across the street (Commercial Dr.). If the zoning is approved, the owner will still need to obtain Site Plan/Plan of Operation approval from the Town.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

Based on the above analysis, the Planning and Zoning Division Staff recommends **approval** of the rezone request. The proposal is consistent with Town and County plan recommendations and would not be considered a spot zoning change since the proposed zoning is consistent the current zoning of two adjacent parcels. Furthermore, the proposed use is consistent with other commercial uses recently approved nearby on Commercial Drive and is an appropriate use along STH 59.

**Section 2: Severability.**



## DECLARATION OF RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS

THIS DECLARATION OF RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS (“Declaration”) is executed as of February XX, 2024, by Waukesha County (“Declarant”).

### RECITALS

- A. The Declarant is the owner of certain real property located in Waukesha County, Wisconsin, as described on the attached “Exhibit A” and referred to on the exhibit and in this Declaration as (“Right-of-Way”).
- B. The Declarant owns and operates an airport known as Waukesha County Airport – Crites Field (“Airport”) which is a federally obligated property.
- C. The Declarant has a plan for the construction, operation, and maintenance of a realigned segment of Silvernail Road, a public road, on the right-of-way established on Transportation Project Plat No: AIP 3-55-00900-38P. Transportation Project Plat No. AIP 3-55-0090-38P – 4.01 & 4.02 recorded as document No. XXXXX & XXXXX are attached hereto as “Exhibit B” and made a part hereof by reference.
- D. As a recipient of federal airport improvement grants, the Declarant is obligated to comply with federal grant assurances established by the Federal Aviation Administration. In order to meet those obligations, the Declarant agrees to limit its use of the Right-of-Way in the manner described below.

### DECLARATION

The Declarant declares that:

- 1. Declarant agrees to operate, construct, and maintain a realigned segment of Silvernail Road, a public road, within the Right-of-Way, so long as the public road and activities do not interfere with normal Airport operations or jeopardize the safety of Airport users.
- 2. Declarant reserves the right to further develop or improve the Airport as it sees fit, regardless of the impact to Silvernail Road.
- 3. Following the initial construction, the Declarant agrees that any improvements on the Right-of-Way shall be constructed and maintained at no cost to the Federal Aviation Administration, unless required by the Federal Aviation Administration. Should the public road in the Right-of-Way require relocation, the same shall be done with no

federal participation unless approved for a Federal Aviation or Highway Administration grant or requested by the Federal Aviation or Highway Administration.

4. Declarant agrees to not complete public road improvements within the Right-of-Way, except at such times as may be designated for such purposes by Airport staff. Airport staff shall not unreasonably refuse to designate such times, and such times so designated shall be those reasonably related to the unobstructed taking off, landing and flight of the aircraft. Notwithstanding any other provision in this paragraph, however, Declarant may upon notification to Airport staff or through established protocols, bring any vehicle and equipment into, and conduct repair, maintenance, and other operations within the Right-of-Way in the event of an emergency arising with respect to the public road.
5. Declarant reserves the use and benefit of the public, a right of flight for the passage of aircraft in the airspace above the surface of the Right-of-Way, together with the right to cause in the airspace such noise as may be inherent in the operation of aircraft, now known or hereafter used, for navigation of or flight in the airspace, and for use of the airspace for landing at, taking off from, or operating from the Airport.
6. Declarant reserves the use and benefit of the public, a right of entry onto the Right-of-Way to cut, remove, or lower any building, structure, poles, trees, or other object, whether natural or otherwise, of a height in excess of Federal Aviation Regulation (FAR) Part 77 surfaces relating to the Airport. This public right includes the right to mark or light as obstructions to air navigation, any and all buildings, structures, poles, trees, or other object that may at any time project or extend above said surfaces.
7. Declarant agrees to restrict the height of structures, objects of natural growth, and other obstructions on the Right-of-Way to a height which does not exceed the height requirements set forth in Part 77 of the FAA Regulations, as amended, or any similar regulations which may hereinafter be enacted relating to the Airport.
8. Declarant agrees to file a notice consistent with requirements of FAR Part 77 (FAA Form 7460-1) prior to constructing any facility, structure, or other item on the Right-of-Way.
9. Declarant agrees that the Right-of-Way will only be used for purposes compatible with the Airport including a public road.
10. Declarant agrees to not hereafter use, permit, or suffer use of the Right-of-Way in such a manner as to create electrical interference with radio communication between the installation upon the Airport and aircraft or as to make it difficult for fliers to distinguish between airport lights and others, or as to impair visibility in the vicinity

of the Airport, or as otherwise to endanger the landing, taking off, or maneuvering of aircraft.

11. Declarant agrees to not hereafter use, permit, or suffer use of the Right-of-Way in such a manner as to create a potential for attracting birds and other wildlife which may pose a hazard to aircraft.
12. Declarant agrees that in the event the Right-of-Way is no longer used as a public road, it shall revert to Airport use.

#### MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

13. Covenants Run with Right-of-Way. All terms and conditions in this Declaration, including the benefits and burdens, shall run with the land and shall be binding upon, the Declarant, its successors and assigns, as owner and operator of the Airport.
14. Subordination. This Declaration shall be subordinate to the provisions of and requirements of any existing or future agreements between Declarant and the United States or the State of Wisconsin, relative to the operation or maintenance of the Airport, the execution of which has been or may be required as a condition precedent to the expenditure of federal or state funds for the development of the Airport.
15. Amendment. This Declaration may be amended by the recording of a written instrument executed by the Declarant to include provisions required by agreements with the United States or the State of Wisconsin.
16. Termination. This Declaration shall be terminated in the event the Airport ceases to operate and is permanently closed.



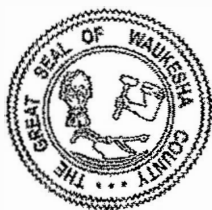



The department intends to fund this subscription beginning in the 2025 budget through a combination of staffing level adjustments and reductions to operating expenses (e.g., physical evidence storage, such as thumb drives, and transcription costs) that are expected to be possible in part due to efficiencies gained from this software. Department management indicates that the plan to absorb these costs will be refined as system functionality is implemented.

Due to workforce recruitment and challenges within today's labor market, department management is requesting to create a Senior Mental Health Counselor position to carryout the duties previously assigned to a difficult-to-fill Registered Nurse position within the Mental Health Center. This will allow the county to broaden the scope of recruitment efforts.

This position change is estimated to result in \$13,700 of lower costs on an annualized basis (not including potential changes in employee benefit plan selection), assuming the respective mid-points in each salary range.

2 ACCEPT THE HEALTHY BRAIN INITIATIVE ROAD MAP STRATEGIST GRANT  
3 FUNDING AND APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURES  
4

5 WHEREAS, the Alzheimer's Association has awarded the Waukesha County Department of  
6 Health and Human Services (HHS) a Healthy Brain Initiative Road Map Strategist (HBI) grant  
7 of \$48,000 to be used between January 1, 2024 – November 30, 2024; and  
8

9 WHEREAS, available revenues were not anticipated nor included in the 2024 budget; and  
10

11 WHEREAS, the HBI grant is designed to increase knowledge and awareness about Alzheimer's  
12 as a public health issue; expand the understanding of the impact and burden of cognitive  
13 impairment; and advance public health strategies to address cognitive health, cognitive  
14 impairment, Alzheimer's, and other dementias; and  
15

16 WHEREAS, HHS will utilize the funding to focus on increasing additional organization  
17 collaboration, providing education and awareness for prevention and early detection of  
18 Alzheimer's, and increasing risk reduction efforts related to dementia in partnership with the  
19 Waukesha County Aging and Disability Resource Center; and  
20

21 WHEREAS, \$17,386 of the HBI grant will cover 0.20 FTE of a Public Health Community  
22 Health Educator position that is already included in the 2024 adopted budget, so only \$30,614 of  
23 additional appropriations are needed.  
24

25 THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS  
26 that the Waukesha County Department of Health and Human Services is authorized to accept the  
27 Healthy Brain Initiative Road Map Strategist grant of \$48,000 from the Alzheimer's Association.  
28

29 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the 2024 Waukesha County Department of Health and  
30 Human Services budget be modified to increase other revenue by \$30,614 and operating  
31 expenses by \$30,614 to provide education, training, and community outreach related to  
32 preventing dementia and encouraging early diagnosis.


**MODIFY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES 2024 BUDGET TO  
ACCEPT THE HEALTHY BRAIN INITIATIVE ROAD MAP STRATEGIST GRANT  
FUNDING AND APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURES**

This ordinance authorizes the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) to accept the Healthy Brain Initiative Road Map Strategist (HBI) grant of \$48,000 and modifies the 2024 budget to appropriate \$30,614 of additional operating expenses and increase general government revenue of \$30,614. The Healthy Brain Initiative Road Map Strategist (HBI) grant can be used to increase knowledge and awareness about Alzheimer's as a public health issue, expand the understanding of the impact and burden of cognitive impairment, and advance public health strategies to address cognitive health. The grant period is through November 30, 2024.

The ordinance appropriates \$30,614 for 2024, as described in the table below.

1 ESTABLISH SALARIES FOR COUNTY CLERK, REGISTER OF DEEDS, AND  
2 TREASURER FOR 2025 - 2028  
3

4 WHEREAS, the Waukesha County Code of Ordinances states that the County Clerk, Register of  
5 Deeds, and Treasurer shall receive salaries as determined by the County Board; and  
6

7 WHEREAS, the next four-year term of office for the County Clerk, Register of Deeds, and  
8 Treasurer will begin in 2025; and  
9

10 WHEREAS, pursuant to Wisconsin State Statutes, any changes in compensation must be adopted  
11 in advance of processing nomination papers and the election; and  
12

13 WHEREAS, reasonable salaries are necessary to attract qualified candidates to these full-time  
14 elected department head positions; and  
15

16 WHEREAS, per Wisconsin law, the County Clerk, Register of Deeds, and Treasurer cannot  
17 participate in the County performance management compensation program; and  
18

19 WHEREAS, a 3% salary increase is appropriate for the Register of Deeds in 2025 and, for  
20 internal equity purposes, a 4.4% salary increase is appropriate for the County Clerk and the  
21 Treasurer in 2025 to be in alignment with the Register of Deeds; and

23 WHEREAS, a 3% salary increase is appropriate for the County Clerk, Register of Deeds, and  
24 Treasurer in 2026, 2027, and 2028.

5   WHEREAS, Waukesha County, Wisconsin (the "County") is in need of an amount not to exceed

11   WHEREAS, it is desirable to authorize the issuance of general obligation promissory notes for
