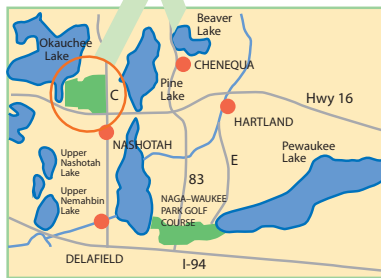
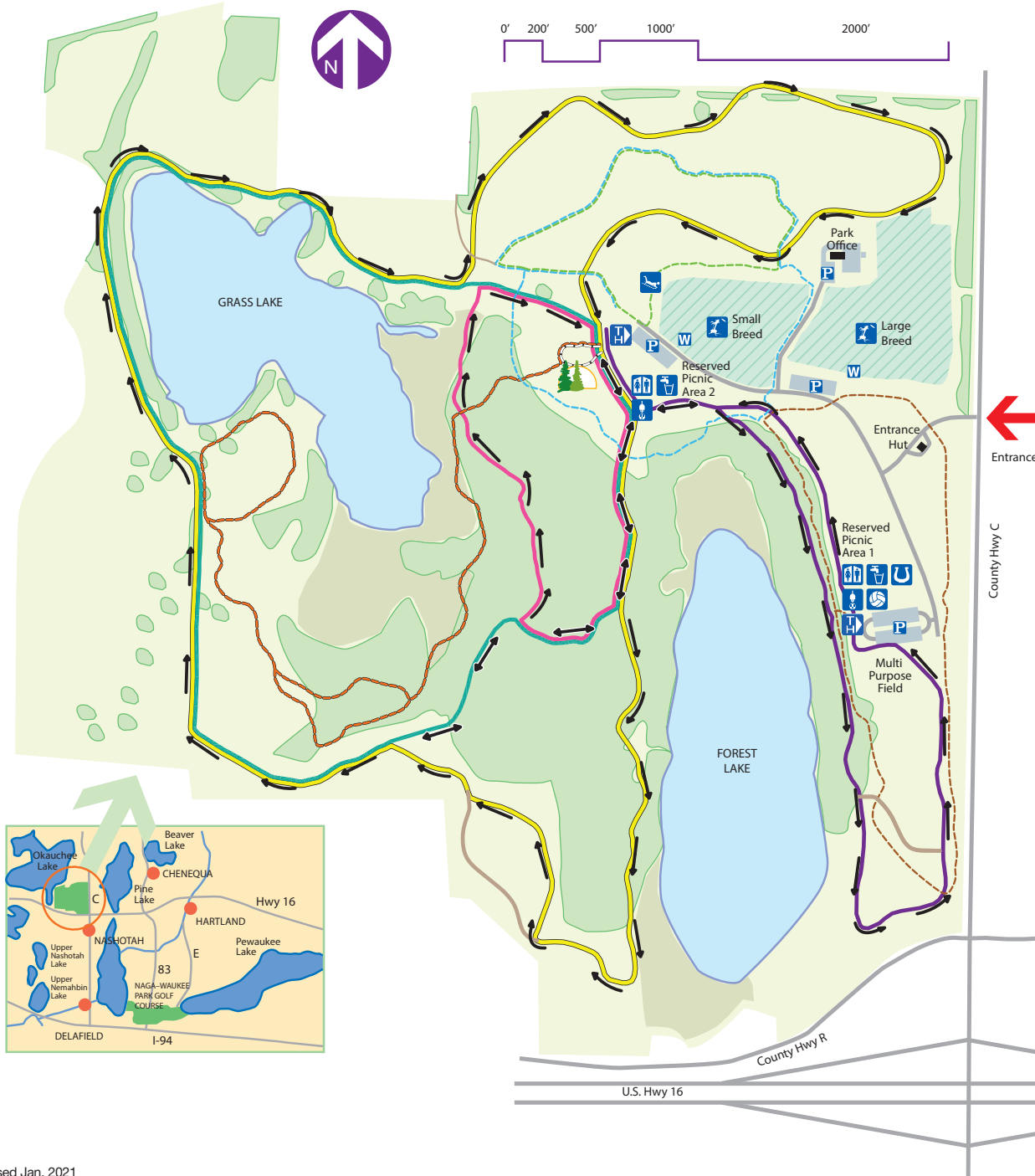

- Blue/Green Loop - 1.9 Miles (Winter = Ski Only)
- Purple Loop - 1.4 Miles (Winter = Ski Only)
- Pink Loop - 0.9 Mile, Steep (Winter = Ski Only)
- One-way Trail
- Two-way Trail

## Hiking, Snowshoeing, Walking Trails

- Orange Hiking Loop - 1.3 Miles (Winter = Ungroomed)
- Brown Hiking Loop - 1.2 Miles (Winter = Ungroomed)
- Blue Hiking Loop - 1.15 Miles (Winter = Ungroomed)
- Green Hiking Loop - 0.75 Mile (Winter = Ungroomed)
- White Hiking Loop - 0.1 Mile (Winter = Ungroomed)

Groomed trails are for cross-country skiing only.



Entrance

Skiers should follow the one-way traffic patterns as identified on the map. Be aware that there are some two-way areas on the trails.



Hikers, Snowshoers, Walkers and Pets should use the ungroomed trails for winter activities. No bikes allowed.

Please respect the groomed trails to keep them in the best condition for users and staff.

Be aware of trail crossings and yield to skiers at crossings.
