The defendant involved in the Town of Waukesha incident has been identified. Adam Roth a 36 year-old male has been charged with two counts of 1st-Degree Intentional Homicide use of a dangerous weapon, two counts of Attempt 1st-Degree Intentional Homicide use of a dangerous weapon, one count of 1st-Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety use of a dangerous weapon and one count of Mistreatment of Animals/ Causing Death use of a dangerous weapon.

Critical Incident - Town of Waukesha

On Tuesday, March 10, 2020, at 6:45pm, the Waukesha County Sheriff's Office responded for a report of a possible domestic disturbance at a residence in the Town of Waukesha.

Initial investigation revealed that four victims were stabbed at the residence. Two victims succumb to their injuries and were pronouced deceased, and two victims were transported via ambulance to area hospitals. One subject was taken into custody on scene. At this time, there is no active threat to the community.

The incident remains under investigation by the Waukesha County Sheriff's Office and the name's of the deceased are being withheld due to pending notification of the family. Assistance was received from the City of Waukesha and Town of Mukwanago Police Departments, along with Town of Waukesha, Town of Vernon and North Prarie Fire Departments.
