Drowning- Menomonee County Park

On Thursday, July 28, 2022, at 7:03 p.m., The Waukesha County Sheriff's Department responded to Menomonee County Park for a reported drowning. When law enforcement arrived, the 14-year-old unresponsive juvenile had already been removed from the water. Citizens on scene were performing CPR until rescue efforts were turned over to law enforcement and fire department personnel. The juvenile regained a pulse and was transported via ambulance and flight for life to an area hospitals.

The Sheriff's Office would like to thank the citizens on scene for taking action in removing the juvenile from the water and preforming life saving measures.

The Waukesha County Sheriff's Office was assisted by the Parks Department and Menomonee Falls Fire Department.

This incident remains under investigation by the Waukesha County Sheriff's Office.
