PROPOSED ORDINANCE 157-107

REPEAL WAUKESHA COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES AND
CREATE NEW WAUKESHA COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the Waukesha County Code of Ordinances was first codified in 1987, and

WHEREAS, since 1987, Waukesha County government has undergone a number of significant changes, and

WHEREAS, because of governmental changes and other reasons the Code has been added to, deleted from and otherwise modified over the last fifteen years, and

WHEREAS, as a result of the changes noted above, the Code has become disorganized and difficult to read.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS that:

Section 1. The code entitled "Waukesha County Code" and consisting of Chapters 1 through 28 is repealed and a new code entitled "Waukesha County Code" is adopted. The Waukesha County Code supercedes and repeals all general and permanent legislation included in or intended to amend, repeal or create new sections of the Waukesha County Code and adopted by the Waukesha County Board of Supervisors on or before July 1, 2002, that is not included in the Code or recognized and continued in force by reference therein.

Section 2. This ordinance does not revive any legislation that has been repealed by legislation that is repealed by this ordinance.


Section 3. Additions or amendments to the Code, when passed in a form as to indicate the intention to make them a part of the Code shall be deemed incorporated in the Code, so that reference to the Code shall be understood and intended to include additions and amendments.


Section 4. Any ordinance adopted after July 1, 2002 that amends or refers to legislation that has been codified in the Code shall be construed as if it refers to like provisions of the Code.

Section 5. This ordinance and the Code adopted by this ordinance shall be effective as provided by law.




