3 ACCEPT AND APPROVE THE REALLOCATION OF
4 1998 FEDERAL DISASTER RECOVERY INITIATIVE PROJECTS
5 FUNDED THROUGH THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE

8 WHEREAS, President Clinton declared portions of Waukesha County a Federal Disaster
9 (Disaster Declaration #FEMA-DR-1238) due to flooding which occurred in August of 1998, and
10

11 WHEREAS, Federal Funds through the 1998 Disaster Recovery Initiative were provided for
12 affected flooded areas through the State Department of Commerce, and
13

14 WHEREAS, the State Department of Commerce established priorities, low and moderate income
15 requirements, and the allocation formula for the affected areas including \$690,996 to Waukesha
16 County, and
17

18 WHEREAS, applications were solicited, and allocations to specific disaster recovery initiative
19 projects were previously approved by the CDBG Board and the County Board as submitted by
20 approved enrolled Ordinance (#155-11) for transmission to the State Department of Commerce
21 and the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for approval, and

23 WHEREAS, the above mentioned submitted allocation plan for disaster recovery initiative
24 projects was not acceptable and no budget appropriations were expended, and
25

26 WHEREAS, the funding allocation plan has been revised to meet the low and moderate income
27 household benefit criteria established by the State Department of Commerce.

29 THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES
30 ORDAIN that the transmission of the revised 2002 Recommended Disaster Recovery Initiative
31 Projects, which is on file in the County Clerk's Office, is approved.
32

33 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the County Executive is authorized to execute grant
34 agreements, subgrantee agreements and appropriate amendments that are deemed reasonable and
35 appropriate, and other documents as necessary, to receive Federal Disaster Recovery Initiative
36 reimbursement funds.


38 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Community Development Program is authorized to
39 accept Disaster Recovery Initiative funds in the amount of \$690,966 on behalf of Waukesha
40 County.


42 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the 2002 Community Development Program budget be

44 2002 program budget expenditures by a corresponding amount to cover the project costs
45 associated with the disaster recovery initiative projects.


