3 AUTHORIZE THE WAUKESHA COUNTY UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN
4 EXTENSION TO ACCEPT U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND
5 HUMAN SERVICES SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND MENTAL
6 HEALTH SERVICES ADMINISTRATION GRANT FUNDS

9 WHEREAS the U. S. Department of Health and Human Services provides substance abuse and
10 mental health services funding and has chosen Waukesha County University of Wisconsin
11 Extension to provide and conduct additional violence prevention education in the Haertel Field
12 and Phoenix Heights neighborhood revitalization areas in the City of Waukesha, and
13

14 WHEREAS the U. S. Department of Health and Human Services authorizes the Waukesha
15 County University of Wisconsin-Extension to continue to develop and implement youth, family
16 and neighborhood educational and enrichment services to youth and families under served by
17 current community resources, and
18

19 WHEREAS this represents an opportunity to Waukesha County University of Wisconsin-
20 Extension to continue expansion of data collection, research, educational and prevention
21 programs engaging diverse stakeholders from the Haertel Field (Saratoga) and Phoenix Heights
22 (White Rock) neighborhood revitalization areas, and

24 WHEREAS the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin-Extension is facilitating the
25 development of a comprehensive, culturally-appropriate educational plan for Haertel Field and
26 Phoenix Heights neighborhoods' youth and families that focuses on specific actions and
27 measurable results to prevent violence and improve community life, and

29 WHEREAS the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin-Extension will facilitate the
30 development of a compelling evaluation process into program planning efforts, and
31

32 WHEREAS the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin-Extension in collaboration with
33 neighborhood committees and residents will develop a plan for additional service and expansion
34 efforts, and

36 WHEREAS the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin Extension applied for the grant in
37 2001 but was not notified of the grant award of \$191,316 for the grant period September 30,
38 2002 to September 29, 2003 until late in the 4th quarter, too late to be included in the 2003
39 adopted budget, and

41 WHEREAS these grant revenues and expenditures need to be appropriated in the University of
42 Wisconsin Extension 2003 budget.


44 THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES
45 ORDAIN that the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin-Extension be authorized to accept
46 the grant award of \$191,316 from the U. S. Department of Health and Human Services Division
47 of Grants Management, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration to provide
48 and conduct additional violence prevention education in the Haertel Field and Phoenix Heights
49 neighborhood revitalization areas in the City of Waukesha.

51 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the County's University of Wisconsin Extension 2003
52 budget be modified by increasing Intergovernmental Grant Revenue by \$191,316 and operating
53 expense appropriation by \$178,750, Interdepartmental expense appropriation by \$12,566.


