3 MODIFY THE WAUKESHA COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT'S 2003

8 WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has appropriated funding to
9 assist State and local governments for the updating of Emergency Operations Plans and other
10 terrorism related planning activities, and
11

12 WHEREAS, State and local governments are to use this funding to update their Emergency
13 Operations Plans for all hazards with special emphasis on Weapons of Mass Destruction
14 terrorism preparedness, and
15

16 WHEREAS, the grant will be disbursed through the Wisconsin Emergency Management division
17 (WEM), and
18

19 WHEREAS, Waukesha County is required to produce and provide specific deliverables to the
20 WEM per FEMA guidelines in order to receive reimbursement, and
21

22 WHEREAS, Waukesha County is awarded \$48,295 based on a WEM allocation formula to assist
23 in producing the required deliverables.
24

25 WHEREAS, the Emergency Management office is requesting to increase a current part time staff
26 position to be a full time staff position for the duration of the grant to assist in completing these
27 deliverables as the grant will provide sufficient funding to allow additional staff support for a
28 limited period.
29

30 THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WAUKESHA COUNTY DOES ORDAIN
31 that the Waukesha County Emergency Management Office be authorized to accept \$48,295 of
32 grant funding through Wisconsin Emergency Management for terrorism related planning
33 activities.

35 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Emergency Management Office 2003 budget be
36 modified by increasing inter-governmental revenues and appropriate Personnel, Operating, and
37 Interdepartmental expenditure appropriations by an amount not to exceed \$48,295.

39 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that one regular part time position of Clerk Typist I/II in the
40 County Executive's Office under the Emergency Management Office budget, will be changed to
41 regular full time effective upon final approval of this ordinance and will revert back to regular
42 part time effective December 16, 2003.
