8 WHEREAS, the State Office of Justice Assistance has made federal Local Law Enforcement
9 Block Grant (LLEBG) grant funds available to counties for law enforcement purposes, and

11 WHEREAS, these grant funds became available after the 2002 budget process had been
12 completed,

14 WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Department has identified the need to upgrade officer and citizen
15 safety through use of a more secure holster for the officer's weapon, and

17 WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Department has also identified the need to upgrade officer safety in the
18 corrections division through use of food pass through and chute cuff devices, and



20 WHEREAS, such equipment qualifies for LLEBG funds.



22 THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WAUKESHA COUNTY DOES ORDAIN
23 that the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department be authorized to accept a federal Local Law
24 Enforcement Block Grant grant through the State Office of Justice Assistance not to exceed
25 \$12,239 to fund upgrading officer holsters and jail safety equipment.



28 \$12,239, by increasing fund balance transfer revenues by the amount of the \$12,239, and
29 authorizing the appropriation of \$12,239 by increasing related budget expenditure accounts to
30 cover costs associated with the upgrades.


