13 new canine, provide dog and handler training, and squad kennel equipment.



19 fund the purchase, training and equipment of a new canine unit.






## FISCAL NOTE

### AMEND SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT 2003 BUDGET EXPENDITURE OF DONATED FUNDS

This ordinance authorizes the Sheriff's Department to accept and spend a grant of \$10,400 from the Waukesha Kennel Club to acquire, train and equip a dog to replace a retired dog. This would allow the Department to maintain a complement of four dogs, of which three are patrol specialists and one (the new dog being proposed) is trained to function in either a patrol or drug-detection role.

Under the terms of an April 2000 settlement agreement, dog handlers are allowed 6.25 hours per week away from their other duties to care for their animals.

Approval of this ordinance results in no new levy impact.
