11 WHEREAS, these funds became available after the 2003 budget process was completed, and



17 that the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department be authorized to accept \$10,000 in Department
18 of Justice reimbursable funds to purchase equipment to support its participation in the federal
19 anti-terrorism task force.

21 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Sheriff's Department 2003 budget be modified by
22 increasing inter-governmental revenues by the amount of \$10,000, and authorizing the
23 appropriation of \$10,000 by increasing related budget equipment expenditure accounts for
24 identified equipment purchases.



FISCAL NOTE

ACCEPT REIMBURSEMENT FOR EQUIPMENT SUPPORTING SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT PARTICIPATION IN FEDERAL ANTI-TERRORISM TASK FORCE

This ordinance authorizes the Sheriff's Department to accept a U.S. Department of Justice anti-terrorism task force grant in the amount of \$10,000. The funds would be used to purchase of two hand-held radios, two laptop computers and three digital cameras. The Sheriff's Department has identified those items as supporting its participation in the task force, and any subsequent maintenance or repair costs would be absorbed within the existing operating budget.

The ordinance modifies the Department's 2003 budget to increase grant revenues and related expenditure accounts by \$10,000. There is no additional direct impact on 2003 tax levy.
