14 Agreement covering a portion of C.T.H. G for transfer to the Town of Delafield.

17 ORDAIN that the County Executive may execute the Jurisdictional Transfer Agreement


21 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the County Department of Public Works is directed to take
