PROPOSED RESOLUTION 158-4-

SUPPORT FOR GRADE SEPARATION AT THE RAILROAD  
CROSSING ON COUNTY HIGHWAY K

6 WHEREAS the County owns and operates County Trunk Highway K, and

7  
8 WHEREAS County Trunk Highway K crosses the Canadian National Railroad at grade, and

9  
10 WHEREAS currently thirty trains per day move over the railroad crossing at County Trunk  
11 Highway K at an average speed of thirty to forty miles per hour, and

12  
13 WHEREAS 14,900 vehicles per day move over the railroad crossing at an average speed of  
14 forty-five miles per hour, and

15  
16 WHEREAS the resulting exposure factor equals 447,000, and Federal guidelines recommend  
17 grade separation when the exposure factor exceeds 100,000, and

18  
19 WHEREAS commercial and residential developments either underway or planned will add over  
20 1,200 new homes and businesses in the area around the crossing thereby adding to traffic counts  
21 and increasing the exposure factor, and

22  
23 WHEREAS train movements and switching operations can lead to long waits for emergency  
24 vehicles, thereby creating a situation detrimental to the health, safety and welfare of County  
25 residents.

27 THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS DOES RESOLVE that the Wisconsin  
28 Commissioner of Railroads be requested to investigate the feasibility and necessity for a grade  
29 separation at the railroad crossing on County Trunk Highway K (Crossing Number 692-  
30 245A/CM 105.23).

32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to the Wisconsin  
33 Commissioner of Railroads, the Governor, the Secretary of the Wisconsin Department of  
34 Transportation and the members of the Waukesha County delegation to the State Legislature.
