

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 159-105

AUTHORIZE THE WAUKESHA COUNTY U.W. EXTENSION NUTRITION COALITION TO ACCEPT THE COMMUNITY SERVICE BLOCK GRANT (CSBG) FROM THE COMMUNITY ACTION COALITION FOR SOUTH CENTRAL WISCONSIN, INC. (CAC) GRANT AND TO AUTHORIZE THE ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURE APPROPRIATIONS TO TEACH LIFE SKILLS IN GARDENING, NUTRITION, AND FOOD SAFETY TO HUBER INMATES AND DELIVER FRESH PRODUCE TO THE WAUKESHA AREA FOOD PANTRIES AND MEAL SITES

WHEREAS, the Community Action Coalition (CAC) provides the third consecutive year of funding for the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin Extension to teach Huber inmates life skills in gardening, nutrition, and food safety, and

WHEREAS, the Community Action Coalition (CAC) anticipates that the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin Extension will collaborate with Waukesha area food pantries and meal sites to provide fresh produce grown from this Huber garden project, and

WHEREAS, the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin Extension 2005 adopted budget did not include this \$4,000 grant funding award for this purpose, and, therefore, it needs to be appropriated in the University of Wisconsin Extension 2005 budget, and

WHEREAS, the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin Extension estimates the total cost of this educational program to be \$6,106 of which the County's in-kind portion is \$500 and the State University of Wisconsin Extension's in-kind portion is \$1,606, and

WHEREAS, the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin Extension will provide participants with new knowledge to improve their quality of life, reduce recidivism and provide low-income recipients with fresh produce to improve their overall nutritional health.


THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES ORDAIN that the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin Extension (U.W. Extension) be authorized to accept the grant funding of \$4,000 from the Community Action Coalition to teach gardening, nutrition, and food safety life skills to Huber inmates.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Waukesha County U.W. Extension office 2005 Environmental program budget be modified to increase General Governmental Revenues by \$4,000, and increase Personnel Cost appropriations for temporary extra help by \$3,400, Operating Expense appropriations by \$400, and Interdepartmental Expense appropriations by \$200 for program costs associated with fulfilling the purpose of the grant.
