

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 159-110

LAYING OUT, RELOCATION AND IMPROVEMENT OF COUNTY TRUNK
HIGHWAY "Q" – PROJECT I.D. 02-2751(13)(A) – COLGATE ROAD TO S.T.H. 175 –
VILLAGE OF MENOMONEE FALLS, VILLAGE OF GERMANTOWN,
WAUKESHA COUNTY – WASHINGTON COUNTY

WHEREAS the County Board of Supervisors of Waukesha County finds that the proper improvement in maintenance of County Trunk Highway "Q" in the Village of Menomonee Falls and Village of Germantown from a point that is 4.38 feet south of and 1324.49 feet west of the Southeast corner of Section 31, Town 9 North, Range 20 East, Village of Germantown to a point that is 26.39 feet south of and 1133.33 feet west of the Northeast corner of Section 6, Town 8 North, Range 20 East, Village of Menomonee Falls, requires certain relocation or changes and the acquisition of certain rights of way as shown on the plat marked "Plat of Right of Way Required for C.T.H. "Q", Project I.D. 02-2751(13)(A), C.T.H. "Q", Colgate Road to S.T.H. 175, Waukesha County."

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES ORDAIN that County Trunk Highway "Q" is hereby changed or relocated from a point that is 4.38 feet south of and 1324.49 feet west of the Southeast corner of Section 31, Town 9 North, Range 20 East, Village of Germantown to a point that is 26.39 feet south of and 1133.33 feet west of the Northeast corner of Section 6, Town 8 North, Range 20 East, Village of Menomonee Falls, as shown on the plat marked "Plat of Right of Way Required for C.T.H. "Q", Project I.D. 02-2751(13)(A), C.T.H. "Q", Colgate Road to S.T.H. 175, Waukesha County," said plat on file in the County Clerk's office and adopted by reference under the authority granted by Section 83.08 and Chapter 32 of the Wisconsin Statutes.
