

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 160-134

AMEND THE WAUKESHA COUNTY CODE TO REPEAL AND RECREATE SECTIONS REGARDING ESTABLISHING AND CREATING TWENTY-FIVE SUPERVISORY DISTRICTS IN WAUKESHA COUNTY

WHEREAS pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes, Chapter 59.10 (3)(b)(2), a new plan for County Supervisory Districts must be adopted by the County Board after each decennial census of population, and

WHEREAS Year 2005 Wisconsin Act 100 amends Chapter 59.10, Wisconsin Statutes setting forth criteria and procedures under which either a county board or the electors of the county by petition and referendum may decrease the number of county supervisors after the county board enacts its decennial supervisory district plan, and

WHEREAS any redistricting plan enacted by the county board takes effect on November 15 following its enactment and first applies to the election of supervisors at the next spring election following the effective date that immediately precedes the expiration of the terms of office of supervisors in the county, and

WHEREAS following the provisions of 59.10 (3) (cm), Wisconsin Statutes, a modified plan was developed reducing the number of Supervisory Districts to twenty-five.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Section 4-2 of the Waukesha County Code of Ordinances shall be repealed and recreated to read:

(a) *Descriptions.* The twenty-five (25) supervisory districts referred to in Section 4-2 are hereby created, numbered and described as follows:

(b) References in this section to boundaries or minor civil divisions of wards of municipalities are those that exist on January 1, 2006.

(c) The supervisory districts created and described in detail in this section shall further be described in detail by an Official Map of the County of Waukesha, identified and marked "Waukesha County Supervisory Districts." The aforementioned map shall be on file in the County Clerk's office and shall be considered a part of this section the same as if set out in full.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect on November 15 following its enactment and first applies to the election of supervisors at the next spring election following the effective date that immediately precedes the expiration of the terms of office of supervisors in the county

SECTION 3. The provisions of this ordinance shall be included and incorporated in the Code of Ordinances of the County of Waukesha, Wisconsin, as an addition or amendment thereto and shall be appropriately renumbered to conform to the numbering system contained therein.

SECTION 4. Any code section or part of a section in conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed and declared null and void and of no effect.






## Proposed 25 Supervisory Plan - Version 2
