

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 160-54

AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES-CRIMINAL JUSTICE COLLABORATING COUNCIL TO ACCEPT THE FEDERAL DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FISCAL YEAR 2005 DRUG COURT DISCRETIONARY GRANT

WHEREAS Waukesha County enrolled ordinance 157-68 created the Criminal Justice Collaborating Council, which includes key justice system policymakers and administrators, to analyze criminal justice system needs, develop criminal justice programming, monitor programming and administer resources, and

WHEREAS the United States Department of Justice has made grant funding available to develop a substance abuse treatment court under the Federal Drug Court Discretionary Grant Program, and

WHEREAS the Waukesha County Criminal Justice Collaborating Council applied for and was granted a \$450,000 multi-year grant to develop a program to reduce Operating While Intoxicated (OWI) recidivism by requiring offenders to participate in substance abuse treatment under strict judicial supervision, and

WHEREAS the required 25 percent matching funds will consist of a combination of in-kind and cash expenditures already included in the existing budgets, and

WHEREAS process and outcome evaluations will be conducted to measure performance indicators including recidivism and re-arrest rate, as well as conduct a comparison group study, and

WHEREAS the grant period extends 36 months from the July 1, 2005 effective date of the grant date to June 30, 2008.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES ORDAIN that the Department of Health and Human Services-Criminal Justice Collaborating Council accept the Federal Drug Court Discretionary Grant in the amount of \$450,000.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Department of Health and Human Services-Criminal Justice Collaborating Council 2005 Budget be modified by increasing General Government revenues by \$19,200 and by increasing Operating Expenses by the same amount to cover the estimated 2005 costs associated with purchasing contracted alcohol treatment court coordinator, client case management, client monitoring and evaluation services.


