

ENROLLED RESOLUTION 160-8

SUPPORT DEVELOPMENT OF MEMORANDA OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN  
WAUKESHA COUNTY AND COUNTY MUNICIPALITIES REGARDING  
STATEWIDE VOTER REGISTRATION SYSTEM

WHEREAS, Congress passed the Help America Vote Act of 2002 (HAVA) to create a more uniform voter registration and voting system in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin State Elections Board (SEB) is charged with implementing a Statewide Voter Registration System (SVRS) that complies with HAVA; and

WHEREAS, local units of government understand their obligations and commitments as mandated by HAVA and state statutes to administer, implement and maintain local voter registration information within a centralized SVRS; and

WHEREAS, the State Legislature has enacted legislation which allows local units of government to share technology and resources with the County or other municipalities to maintain the local voter registration information within the centralized SVRS.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA RESOLVES that the County Clerk may enter into discussions with interested county municipalities regarding developing a Memorandum of Understanding with that municipality that will comply with the requirements of the Help America Vote Act of 2002 ( HAVA) and provide a more efficient and cost effective implementation of a Statewide Voter Registration System (SVRS) through the sharing of technology and resources.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that when developing any Memoranda of Understanding pursuant to this Resolution, the technology, security, maintenance, support, and process guidelines developed by the State Elections Board relating to use of the Statewide Voter Registration System (SVRS) will be followed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any Memoranda of Understanding developed pursuant to this Resolution will allow the County to recover the costs of administering and maintaining local voter registration information from the partnering municipalities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any Memorandum of Understanding developed pursuant to this Resolution shall be subjected to the normal Waukesha County review processes, including contract and technology.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution shall be sent to the State Elections Board.
