

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 161-67

REPEAL SECTIONS 18-170 (c) AND (d) OF THE WAUKESHA COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES REFERENCING FEES FOR MEDIATION AND STUDY SERVICES IN WAUKESHA COUNTY CIRCUIT COURT SERVICES DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS the Waukesha County Circuit Court Services Department recommends fees for child custody and/or visitation mediation sessions and child custody and/or visitation studies for County Board approval in the county budget process, and

WHEREAS section 18-170 of the Waukesha County Code of Ordinances specifically references established fees for mediation sessions and custody and/or visitation studies, and

WHEREAS these fees may change as noted and are adopted in the annual county budget, and to avoid a duplicative process where the County Code of Ordinances must be changed by ordinance when these fees change it is advisable to amend the Code to remove references to specific fees and instead refer to schedules of fees on file in the Clerk of Court's office.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES ORDAIN that any changes to fees for child custody and visitation mediation sessions and child custody and visitation studies be specifically identified in the budget book document during the annual budget process and be updated and placed on file in Family Court Counseling Office or Clerk of Circuit Court Office of the Circuit Court Services department.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Waukesha County Code of Ordinances shall be amended as follows:

Section 1. Sections 18-170 (c) and 18-170 (d) of the Waukesha County Code of Ordinances shall be repealed.

Section 2. Section 18-170 (c) shall be recreated to read:

Subject to judicial determination of the indigence of one or both of the parties requiring services, the fee for one or more mediation sessions conducted subsequent to the initial free session, or for a custody and/or visitation study as ordered by the court, shall be set at the amounts listed on the schedule on file in the Office the Waukesha County Clerk of Courts.

Section 3. Sections 18-170 (e) and 18-170 (f) shall be renumbered to consecutively follow section 18-170 (c).

Section 4. This ordinance shall be effective upon approval and publication.

SECTION 5. The provisions of this ordinance shall be included and incorporated in the Code of Ordinances of the County of Waukesha, Wisconsin, as an addition or amendment thereto and shall be appropriately renumbered to conform to the numbering system contained therein.

SECTION 6. Any code section or part of a section in conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed and declared null and void and of no effect.
