WHEREAS, the Department has accumulated enough in donated funds in prior years to now purchase a new canine and also provide dog and handler training.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WAUKESHA COUNTY DOES ORDAIN that the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department 2007 budget be modified by increasing General Fund balance by \$14,650 and authorizing the appropriation of an identical amount by increasing related Operating Expense appropriations to fund the purchase and training of a new canine unit.
