

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 161-94

AMEND THE TEXT OF THE TOWN OF EAGLE ZONING CODE TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL USES TO BE ALLOWED IN THE B-2 AND B-3 BUSINESS AND M-1 INDUSTRIAL DISTRICTS, TO ACCOMMODATE NEW RULES AND REGULATIONS FROM THE STATE REGARDING NON-CONFORMING BUILDINGS AND USES AND THEIR RECONSTRUCTION, ACCOMMODATION OF ADULT-ORIENTED ENTERTAINMENT ESTABLISHMENTS, NEW MEETING AND VOTING REQUIREMENTS IMPOSED BY THE STATE REGARDING THE TOWN'S BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT, CHANGES TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE TOWN'S PUBLIC DISTRICT AND AMENDMENTS TO THE USE REQUIREMENTS OF THE M-1 AND M-2 INDUSTRIAL DISTRICTS (ZT-1645)

WHEREAS the subject matter of this Ordinance having been approved by the Eagle Town Board on July 5, 2006, August 7, 2006 and September 6, 2006 after Public Hearings, and the giving of requisite notice of said hearings, and duly referred to and considered by the Waukesha County Park and Planning Commission, and a recommendation for approval, thereon reported to the Land Use, Parks and Environment Committee and the Waukesha County Board of Supervisors, as required by Section 60.61 of the Wisconsin State Statutes.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES ORDAIN that the Text of the Town of Eagle Zoning Code, adopted by the Town of Eagle on December 1, 1990, is hereby amended to provide for additional uses to be allowed in the B-2 and B-3 Business and M-1 Industrial Districts, to accommodate new rules and regulations from the state regarding non-conforming buildings and uses and their reconstruction, accommodation of adult-oriented entertainment establishments, new meeting and voting requirements imposed by the state regarding the Town's Board of Adjustment, changes to the provisions of the Town's Public District and amendments to the use requirements of the M-1 and M-2 Industrial Districts, more specifically described in the "Staff Report and Recommendation" on file in the office of the Waukesha County Department of Parks and Land Use, and made a part of this Ordinance by reference (ZT-1645), is hereby approved.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Waukesha County Clerk shall file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Town Clerk of Eagle.




