WHEREAS Ozaukee County is interested in a joint action agreement with Waukesha County to share the services of the Emergency Manager, and

WHEREAS the Waukesha County Board and County Executive support the concept of shared services and regional cooperation to better the delivery of services to Waukesha County residents and reduce or eliminate duplication of services in and around Waukesha County and southeastern Wisconsin.

THEREFORE THE WAUKESHA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HEREBY RESOLVES that it supports, in concept, the exploration and development of an agreement with Ozaukee County for shared emergency management services, subject to *approval* by the County Board of any contract proposed for such shared services.




