

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 162-103

AMEND 2008 SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT BUDGET EXPENDITURE
OF SEIZED FUNDS – PARTICIPANT DISTRIBUTION
FEBRUARY, 2008

WHEREAS, enrolled ordinance 141-41 authorizes the Sheriff's Department "... to participate in the program to transfer federally seized property to local enforcement agencies," and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Department has such assets that had not been allocated during the 2008 budget process, and

WHEREAS, the department has agreed to allocate a percentage of assets received to participating Metro Unit agencies.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES ORDAIN that the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department budget be modified by appropriating \$38,848 of federal seized asset revenue received in 2007 (and reserved in general fund balance) and authorizing the appropriation of an identical amount by increasing related Operating Expenses appropriations by \$38,848 for a distribution to participating Metro Unit agencies in accordance with federal seized asset guidelines.
