

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 162-39

ACCEPT HOMELAND SECURITY-URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE FY2006  
PROGRAM FUNDING AND MODIFY THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS 2007  
BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE GRANT REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR  
COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TRAINING (CERT) AND FOR  
EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER UPGRADES

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security designated Waukesha County, along with the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine and Washington Counties as an Urban Area eligible for grant funding to enhance the capabilities to prevent, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism, and

WHEREAS, federal fiscal year 2006 Homeland Security-Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) grant funding is available to the Urban Area agencies, and

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee UASI included a funding request for Waukesha County to enhance citizen participation and preparedness for disaster or terrorism events through the offering of Community Emergency Response Team training courses in Waukesha and Milwaukee Counties, and

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee UASI included a funding request for upgrades to the Waukesha County Emergency Operations Center to ensure effective coordination of resources during emergency and disaster situations, and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security and the Wisconsin Office of Justice Assistance approved the investment justifications, allocated funding and authorized Waukesha County to submit grant applications for these projects.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WAUKESHA COUNTY DOES ORDAIN that the Waukesha County Emergency Preparedness Department-Emergency Management Office be authorized to accept \$96,896 of Federal Homeland Security grant funding.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Emergency Preparedness 2007 budget be modified by increasing Intergovernmental Grant revenue appropriation \$96,896, and increasing Operating expense appropriations by \$94,438 and Interdepartmental expense appropriations by \$2,458.
