WHEREAS, the County and the Village of Hartland have negotiated a Roadway Jurisdictional Limits and Maintenance Responsibilities Agreement, and


WHEREAS, a copy of the Agreement is on file in the office of the Department of Public Works.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the County Department of Public Works is directed to take all necessary actions to implement the terms and conditions of the Agreement.

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





INTERDEPARTMENT AGREEMENT  
ROADWAY JURISDICITONAL LIMITS AND MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITIES

This agreement made the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2007 between Waukesha County hereinafter referred to as "County" and the Village of Hartland hereinafter referred to as "Municipality" shall describe the respective highway jurisdictional limits, and maintenance responsibilities regarding County Trunk Highways within the Municipal boundary.

Statutory Authority

Wisconsin Statute 86.302 requires the annual filing of a report of highway mileage with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation by all towns, villages and counties. Said reports are used as a basis of apportioning state highway aids to local governments. In addition, Statute 86.305 requires an annual certification of municipal boundaries and highway jurisdictional changes. Wisconsin Statute 66.30 provides for intergovernmental cooperative agreements.

Terms of Agreement

1. Jurisdictional Limits:

The County and Municipality do agree that the following county highways enter into or pass through the Municipality as listed below:

E	Maple Ave.	E. Capitol Dr. to Cardinal Lane
E	North Ave.	E. Capitol Dr. to WisDOT ROW (STH 16)
KC	Merton Ave.	E. Capitol Dr. to WisDOT ROW (STH 16)

2. Maintenance Responsibilities:

The County and Municipality further agree that to facilitate winter and summer roadway maintenance that the following roads shall be maintained within the limits shown by the respective parties on the attached spreadsheet. Said maintenance shall be performed without expectation of receiving any compensation therefore. Said maintenance shall include but not be limited to, snow plowing, sanding/salting, pavement maintenance/replacement, shoulder grading, storm drainage maintenance, including curb and gutter, pavement markings and roadway signage.


