

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 163-91

PARTICIPATE IN STATEWIDE AUTOMATED VICTIM INFORMATION AND NOTIFICATION (SAVIN) PROGRAM WITH THE STATE OF WISCONSIN

WHEREAS the State of Wisconsin received a \$1.2 million dollar grant from the federal government to implement a two year membership in the Statewide Automated Victim Information and Notification (SAVIN) program, and

WHEREAS the Wisconsin Department of Corrections (DOC) requested that all counties in the state volunteer to participate in this program through July 1, 2010, and

WHEREAS all costs for participation in this program, including analysis, equipment, interfaces, communications requirements and annual operating costs are paid for directly by the DOC, and

WHEREAS there are no requirements in the federal grant that the program continue after July 1, 2010 once the grant funding expires, and


WHEREAS the Sheriff's Department wishes to participate in this program, which provides automated notification to crime victims about release or change in incarceration status of the person(s) who committed a crime(s) against them, therefore resulting in no fiscal or operational impact to Waukesha County.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS that the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department participate in the Wisconsin Department of Corrections Statewide Automated Victim Information and Notification (SAVIN) grant program.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Department participation in the SAVIN program will end when federal grant funds passed through to the state DOC end, unless other non-levy funding can be obtained for the program.




