

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 163-93

ACCEPT HOMELAND SECURITY-URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE FY2007
PROGRAM FUNDING AND MODIFY THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS
2009 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE GRANT REVENUES AND
EXPENDITURES FOR CITIZEN CORPS INITIATIVES AND
COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TRAINING

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security designated Waukesha County, along with the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine and Washington Counties as an Urban Area eligible for grant funding to enhance the capabilities to prevent, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism, and

WHEREAS, federal fiscal year 2007 Homeland Security-Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) grant funding is available to the Urban Area agencies, and

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee UASI included a funding request for the enhancement of citizen participation and preparedness for disaster or terrorism events through public education materials and training opportunities, and

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee UASI included a funding request for Waukesha County to enhance citizen participation and preparedness for disaster or terrorism events through the offering of Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) training courses in Waukesha and Milwaukee Counties, and

WHEREAS, UASI will provide the funding to pay for third party temporary assistance to coordinate training and outreach efforts; provide educational materials and equipment for participants; develop an informational website; and organize approximately nineteen CERT classes, and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security and the Wisconsin Office of Justice Assistance approved the investment justifications, allocated funding and authorized Waukesha County to submit grant applications for these projects.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS that the Waukesha County Emergency Preparedness Department-Emergency Management Office be authorized to accept \$149,062 of Federal Homeland Security grant funding.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Emergency Preparedness 2009 budget be modified by increasing Intergovernmental Grant revenue appropriation \$149,062, and increasing Personnel cost (temporary extra help) appropriations by \$83,426 and Operating expense appropriations by \$65,636 for grant related expenditures.
