

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 164-20

ACCEPT HOMELAND SECURITY-URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE FY2008
PROGRAM FUNDING AND MODIFY THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS 2009
BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE GRANT REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES
FOR CITIZEN PREPAREDNESS ACTIVITIES

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security designated Waukesha County, along with the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine and Washington Counties as an Urban Area eligible for grant funding to enhance the capabilities to prevent, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism and other all hazard events, and

WHEREAS, federal fiscal year 2008 Homeland Security-Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) grant funding is available to the Urban Area agencies, and

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee UASI included a funding request for the enhancement of citizen participation and preparedness for disaster or terrorism events through public education materials and training opportunities, and

WHEREAS, UASI will provide the funding in this grant to pay for county temporary assistance to coordinate training and outreach efforts; organize Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) classes; provide educational materials and equipment for class participants; continue to develop and maintain an informational website; to provide financial support to coordinate program activities for Milwaukee, Waukesha, and Ozaukee Counties through the Southeast Wisconsin Citizens and Organizations Active in Disaster (COAD) Council; to provide funding to support the Responding to Emergencies And Disasters with Youth (READY program); and to provide funding for the medical reserve corps program, and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security and the Wisconsin Office of Justice Assistance approved the investment justifications, allocated funding, authorized Waukesha County to submit a grant application and issued a grant award for this project.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WAUKESHA COUNTY ORDAINS that the Waukesha County Emergency Preparedness Department-Emergency Management Office be authorized to accept \$250,000 of Federal Homeland Security grant funding.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Emergency Preparedness 2009 budget be modified by increasing Intergovernmental Grant revenue by \$250,000, and increasing Personnel cost-temporary extra help appropriations by \$64,062; Operating expense appropriations by \$184,678; and Interdepartmental charge appropriations by \$1,260 for grant related expenditures.
