

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 164-25

REAUTHORIZATION OF SELF-INSURANCE

WHEREAS, Waukesha County is a qualified political subdivision of the State of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Worker's Compensation Act (Act) provides that employers covered by the Act either insure their liability with worker's compensation insurance carriers authorized to do business in Wisconsin, or can be exempt from insuring liability with a carrier and can assume the responsibility for its own worker's compensation risk and payment (self-insured); and

WHEREAS, the State and its political subdivisions may self-insure worker's compensation without a special order from the Department of Workforce Development (Department) if they agree to report faithfully all compensable injuries and agree to comply with the Act and rules of the Department; and

WHEREAS, Waukesha County opted to be self-insured and currently has in effect a self-insured worker's compensation program; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee approved the continuation of the county's self-insured worker's compensation program, in compliance with DWD 80.60(3), Wis. Admin. Code.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS that the County's self-insured worker's compensation program that is currently in effect shall be continued.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that County Executive Daniel Vrakas is authorized to forward certified copies of this resolution to the Worker's Compensation Division, Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this action by the County Board of Supervisors is taken in accordance with DWD 80.60(3), Wis. Admin. Code, and is intended to constitute a "resolution" as designated by that section.
