ACCEPT 2009 U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE
RECOVERY ACT: EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE
GRANT AWARD AND MODIFY WAUKESHA COUNTY SHERIFF DEPARTMENT'S
2009 BUDGET TO AUTHORIZE GRANT EXPENDITURES

WHEREAS, federal grant funds are available to law enforcement agencies representing Waukesha County, the cities of Waukesha, Brookfield, and New Berlin, and the Village of Menomonee Falls under a joint application, and

WHEREAS, these grant funds became available after the 2009 budget was adopted, and

WHEREAS, the fiduciary agent for the grant is the City of Waukesha Police Department, and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Department desires to make use of these funds for the Criminal Justice Collaborating Council (CJCC) to contract with the Public Policy Forum, a nonpartisan public policy research agency, to provide technical assistance to the CJCC in the areas of criminal justice research, analysis, and evaluation over a three-year period, and

WHEREAS, the Public Policy Forum will match the entire grant amount by providing and funding a research assistant at a minimum of twenty (20) hours per month.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS that the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department 2009 Intergovernmental Revenue Budget be modified by an amount not to exceed \$18,619 and authorize the appropriation of an identical amount in its Operating Expense appropriations to fund expenditures made in accordance with the terms of the grant.
