

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 164-81

REAUTHORIZE “HELPING PATRONS IN THE JOB MARKET” GRANT
FOR FEDERATED LIBRARY SYSTEM AND MODIFY THE 2010
FEDERATED LIBRARY SYSTEM BUDGET

WHEREAS the Waukesha County Federated Library System (WCFLS) has been notified by the state Department of Public Instruction (DPI) that it will receive \$18,000 in Federal Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA) grant funding to continue a project titled, Helping Patrons in the Job Market, and

WHEREAS, as a result of the recent economic downturn, unemployment has been rising across the nation, state and in Waukesha County, and

WHEREAS these LSTA grant funds are planned to be used to help people in Waukesha County who are unemployed or under-employed by providing programs to the public in participating WCFLS member libraries on job information sessions including resume writing, interviewing tips, networking, job searching, and entrepreneurship, and

WHEREAS the funds will also be used to purchase a subscription to LearningExpress Library, which is an online resource that contains interactive courses and practice tests to help people improve their job skills, test preparation, and other basic skills, such as mathematics and reading comprehension, and

WHEREAS the Federated Library System plans to use this grant funding to help train local organizations already serving people dealing with unemployment issues on how to use this online resource, including member libraries, the Workforce Development Center and La Casa de Esperanza, and

WHEREAS the Federated Library System plans to use these funds to help market this online resource to help make County’s residents aware of this service, and

WHEREAS the 2010 Waukesha County budget for the Federated Library System does not include appropriations for this project, and

WHEREAS the proposed use of these grant funds are expected to have no direct impact on either the County General Tax Levy or the Special Library Tax Levy.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS that the Federated Library System may accept up to \$18,000 of Federal Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA) grant funds passed through the state Department of Public Instruction (DPI).




FISCAL NOTE

REAUTHORIZE HELPING PATRONS IN THE JOB MARKET GRANT FOR FEDERATED LIBRARY SYSTEM AND MODIFY THE 2010 FEDERATED LIBRARY SYSTEM BUDGET

According to Department staff, this grant funding will be used to purchase another one-year subscription to the LearningExpress Library online resource for approximately \$12,200, which will help county residents improve various job-related and other basic skills (e.g. test-preparation and mathematical skills). Further, \$5,500 in funding is planned to be used to hire instructors to provide job information sessions to the public (e.g., interview tips, resume writing) at participating member libraries. Marketing efforts for this program are expected to cost \$300. State Department of Public Instruction grant guidelines do not allow grant recipients to claim County indirect cost recovery from this grant. The grant period for this project is from January through December 2010.

No local match dollars are required by this grant. However, the department management estimates that coordinating this project will consume approximately 100 hours of the Department's reference librarian's time, which is totally state funded and already included in the 2010 Adopted Budget. Department management indicates that there are no additional on-going operational costs associated with this grant.

This ordinance results in no additional 2010 direct tax levy impact.
