

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 164-86

ACCEPT HOMELAND SECURITY-URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE FY2009  
PROGRAM FUNDING AND MODIFY THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS 2010  
BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE GRANT REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES  
FOR INTEROPERABLE COMMUNICATIONS PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security designated Waukesha County, along with the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine and Washington Counties as an Urban Area eligible for grant funding to enhance the capabilities to prevent, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism and other all hazard events, and

WHEREAS, federal fiscal year 2009 Homeland Security-Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) grant funding is available to the Urban Area agencies, and

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee UASI included a funding request to purchase additional 800 MHz radios, batteries, chargers, installation and programming costs for Emergency Management, the Village of Menomonee Falls, Village of Mukwonago, and Town of Mukwonago, and

WHEREAS, purchase and installation of 800 MHz trunking radios for the Village and Town of Mukwonago provides all law enforcement agencies in Waukesha County access to the 800 MHz trunking radio system to ensure critical communication capabilities during emergencies, and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security and the Wisconsin Office of Justice Assistance approved the investment justifications, allocated funding, authorized Waukesha County to submit a grant application, and issued a grant award to Waukesha County for funding these interoperable communications projects.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WAUKESHA COUNTY ORDAINS that the Waukesha County Emergency Preparedness Department-Emergency Management Office is authorized to accept \$152,000 of Federal Homeland Security grant funding.



HOMELAND SECURITY-URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE FY2009  
PROGRAM FUNDING AWARD AND MODIFY THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS  
2010 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE GRANT REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES  
FOR INTEROPERABLE COMMUNICATIONS PROJECTS

This ordinance requests the 2010 Emergency Preparedness-Disaster Management program budget be modified to include \$152,000 of federal Homeland Security grant award pass through the State Offices of Justice Assistance increasing revenues and related Operating Expenses by \$152,000 to pay for additional radios for Mukwonago and Menomonee Falls to allow access to the 800 mhz trunking system and expand interoperability capabilities during emergencies. The State Office of Justice Assistance grant period for reimbursement ends November 30, 2010.

According to the Emergency Management Coordinator, the grant funds are to be used to pay for 40 800 MHz radios, batteries, chargers, installation and programming costs for Emergency Management, the Village of Menomonee Falls, Village of Mukwonago and Town of Mukwonago.

This grant results in no additional direct tax levy impact in 2010. Indirect costs are not covered by this grant.
