ACCEPT HOMELAND SECURITY – EMERGENCY RESPONDER TRAINING FUNDING  
AND MODIFY THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS 2010 BUDGET TO  
APPROPRIATE GRANT REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES  
FOR EMERGENCY RESPONDER TRAINING

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security determined that emergency responder training remains a critical factor in local capabilities to prevent, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism and other all hazard events, and

WHEREAS, federal Homeland Security grant funding is available to local agencies in the State of Wisconsin through Wisconsin Office of Justice Assistance via the County Office of Emergency Management, and

WHEREAS, the Menomonee Falls Fire and Police Departments requested local delivery of Critical Incident Management training, and


WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Office of Justice Assistance allocated funding for this training in Waukesha County and requires Waukesha County to act as the fiscal agent to apply for and administer the grant funding on behalf of those local units of government.



ACCEPT HOMELAND SECURITY – EMERGENCY RESPONDER TRAINING  
FUNDING AND MODIFY THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS 2010 BUDGET  
TO APPROPRIATE GRANT REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR  
EMERGENCY RESPONDER TRAINING

This ordinance authorizes the County Emergency Management Office to accept Department of Homeland Security federal funding and modifies the Emergency Preparedness 2010 budgeted revenue and expenditure appropriations by \$7,476.

The purpose of this grant funding is to provide Critical Incident Management training primarily to the Menomonee Falls Police Department. According to department staff, the funding is to be used to compensate course instructors and purchase training materials for 25 participants to attend a three day course planned for September, 2010. This grant funding is expected to cover the estimated costs of instructor fees of \$3,240, instructor travel costs estimated at \$1,373 and participant manuals and materials costs estimated at \$763. In addition, this grant also includes \$2,100 estimated for lodging costs for up to ten out of area attendees if the class is not filled by local area participants.

This grant funded training is expected to result in no additional direct tax levy impact in 2010.
