

ENROLLED RESOLUTION 165-7

ESTABLISH SIZE OF COUNTY BOARD TO FACILITATE
COUNTY SUPERVISORY DISTRICT PLAN

WHEREAS Wisconsin Statute 59.10(3)(b) requires county boards to propose a tentative county supervisory district plan which sets forth the number of supervisory districts and tentative boundaries within 60 days after receipt of the federal decennial census count by block, and,

WHEREAS it is necessary to determine the board size in order to facilitate development and completion of the supervisory districts, tentative boundaries and district maps, and

WHEREAS the Waukesha County Board was reduced to twenty-five supervisors one term ago, and

WHEREAS Waukesha County has the third largest population in the state, and


WHEREAS Wisconsin has a tradition of citizen part-time county boards which facilitate less costly campaigns and distribution of work load as supervisors represent their residents on a broad range of issues including public works, land use, judiciary and law enforcement, human services, as well as participating on boards, commissions and extensive requests for proposals, and


WHEREAS each Waukesha County board member represents more than 15,000 residents per district, which is the highest ratio of residents per supervisor and the lowest number of supervisors per capita out of seventy-one counties in the State of Wisconsin with part-time boards.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Waukesha County Board of Supervisors that the Waukesha County board size be established at twenty-five for the purpose of developing a tentative county supervisory district plan which sets forth the number of supervisory districts and tentative boundaries within 60 days after receipt of the federal decennial census county by block.


