

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 166-121

REPEAL AND RECREATE WAUKESHA COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES TO
REFLECT ALL PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED BENEFITS FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS

WHEREAS, the Waukesha County Code provides that the Clerk of Courts, County Clerk, Treasurer, Register of Deeds, Sheriff, County Board Chairman, and County Executive are eligible for participation in certain benefits on the same basis as non-represented employees, and

WHEREAS, over time the non represented benefits listed in the Code have been modified by the County Board making some of those listed incomplete, and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to update and modify the Waukesha County Code to be consistent with the long-standing intent of the Board as outlined in the Code and to reflect the current non-represented managerial benefit levels.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA
ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Section 7-96 (b) of the Waukesha County Code is repealed and recreated as follows:

The elected officials listed at subsection (a) shall be eligible for participation in the following plans on the same basis as non-represented managerial employees:

1. Health insurance plan (s)
2. Dental insurance plan (s)
3. Group life insurance and Dependent life insurance
4. Section 125 pre-tax programs including premium option, health care reimbursement, and dependent care reimbursement.
5. Long term disability insurance.
6. Retirement health savings plan contribution, plus an additional contribution of 3% of annual salary.
7. Participation in the Wisconsin Retirement system in accordance with State law and with contributions toward the retirement system as required by law.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be effective upon approval and publication.

SECTION 3. The provisions of this ordinance shall be included and incorporated in the Code of Ordinances of the County of Waukesha, Wisconsin, as an addition or amendment thereto and shall be appropriately renumbered to conform to the numbering system contained therein.

SECTION 4. Any code section or part of a section in conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed and declared null and void and of no effect.


