ACCEPT 2009 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) CRIMINAL JUSTICE COORDINATING COUNCILS AWARD THROUGH THE WISCONSIN OFFICE OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE (OJA) AND MODIFY WAUKESHA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES – CRIMINAL JUSTICE COLLABORATING COUNCIL 2011 BUDGET TO AUTHORIZE GRANT EXPENDITURES

WHEREAS, Federal grant funds are available through the Office of Justice Assistance (OJA) as the State Administering Agency to counties with an existing formal Criminal Justice Coordinating Council (CJCC), and

WHEREAS, these grant funds became available after the 2011 budget was adopted, and

WHEREAS, the fiduciary agent for the grant is the Waukesha County Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), and

WHEREAS, HHS – CJCC desires to use these funds to provide local law enforcement agencies within Waukesha County a stipend of approximately \$1,500 for officers who complete a 40-hour Crisis Intervention Training and certification facilitated by the National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) of Greater Milwaukee and Waukesha, and

WHEREAS, this training will allow law enforcement to receive the education and tools necessary to properly recognize individuals with mental illness and refer them to appropriate mental health services in the community, to avoid arrest and to divert them from jail, and

WHEREAS, the grant funding will be used to serve up to 66 law enforcement officers within Waukesha County by providing funds to assist with coverage for an officer to handle law enforcement responsibilities in the community during the weeklong training, and

WHEREAS, the grant funding period for this project is from April 1, 2011 to March 31, 2012.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS that the Waukesha County Department of Health and Human Services- Criminal Justice Collaborating Council is authorized to accept the 2009 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant in the amount of \$100,000, for the purpose of providing local law enforcement agencies within Waukesha County a stipend to attend the 40-hour Crisis Intervention Training and certification facilitated by the National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) of Greater Milwaukee and Waukesha.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the HHS - CJCC general fund 2011 budget be modified to increase General Government revenues from the Office of Justice Assistance by \$100,000 and to increase operating expenses by \$100,000 for associated grant related expenditures.



ACCEPT 2009 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT

WAUKESHA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES –
CRIMINAL JUSTICE COLLABORATING COUNCIL 2011 BUDGET TO AUTHORIZE
GRANT EXPENDITURES

This ordinance authorizes the Waukesha County Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) – Criminal Justice Collaborating Council program to accept and appropriate \$100,000 of Office of Justice Assistance (OJA) grant funding from the State Department of Commerce in their 2011 budget. OJA has indicated that the grant funding period will run from April 1, 2011 to March 31, 2012.

According to the CJCC Coordinator, this grant funding will be used to provide an estimated \$1,500 average stipend per officer to law enforcement agencies within the County for up to 66 law enforcement officers in the Sheriff & police departments to attend a 40 hour Crisis Intervention Training. The stipend amount will help to partially offset costs of coverage for the deputies/officers who attend training. The training is intended to educate and provide the necessary tools needed to help officers properly recognize individuals with possible mental health issues and refer them to appropriate mental health services.
