

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 166-34

ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS UNDER THE COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT LEAD HAZARD REDUCTION GRANT FROM THE
WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION

WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin Department of Administration (formerly Department of Commerce) awarded Waukesha County \$120,000 under the Lead Hazard Reduction Program, and

WHEREAS, Waukesha County accepted and appropriated the initial \$120,000 allocation of Lead Hazard Reduction Program Funds, and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Administration awarded Waukesha County an additional appropriation of up to \$200,000 to eliminate the lead hazard in forty-four rental units to ensure the safety of occupants, and

WHEREAS, these additional funds awarded by the State were not included in the Community Development budget.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS that the Waukesha County Community Development program is hereby authorized to accept and appropriate up to an additional \$200,000 of Lead Hazard Reduction Program funding from the State of Wisconsin.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Waukesha County Community Development budget be modified by increasing General Government Revenues by up to \$200,000 and increasing operating expenses appropriations by up to \$200,000 for costs associated with the carrying out of the Lead Hazard Reduction grant.

FISCAL NOTE

ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS UNDER THE COMMUNITY

DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION

This ordinance authorizes the Community Development program to accept up to \$200,000 of American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Residential Lead Base Paint Hazard funds from the State Department of Administration. The funds will be used to identify elevated lead levels in residences, and perform lead abatement if problems are identified.

According to the Community Development Coordinator, this ordinance provides budget appropriation authority to assess and abate lead hazards in 44 rental units by working with the City of Waukesha and/or Waukesha County's Public Health and Environmental Health divisions and property owners to perform lead assessments and abatements. In addition the Community Development Coordinator plans to use third party contracted services to reform some assessment, inspection and administrative tasks.

This ordinance results in no additional direct tax levy




