

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 167-73

AUTHORIZE COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS WITH LOCAL
UNITS OF GOVERNMENT FOR HOSTING SPATIAL DATA

WHEREAS the Waukesha County Board of Supervisors established the Waukesha County Land Information office with the adoption of Enrolled Ordinance 145-23 on June 19, 1990 under Wisconsin Statute Sect 59.88; and

WHEREAS Section 2 of Enrolled Ordinance 145-23 states “Those duties shall consist of coordinating land information projects within the County, between the County and local governmental units, between the State and local governmental units and among local governmental units, the Federal government and the private sector;” and

WHEREAS the Waukesha County Land Information office has created and maintained multiple spatial datasets including elevation, parcel description, administrative boundaries, soils, land use and aerial imagery which is hosted on an internet web mapping system available to the public; and

WHEREAS local units of government have created and maintain additional spatial datasets including utility systems and asset inventories either with local staff or through contracted services; and

WHEREAS local units of government may find it to their advantage to display their locally created and maintained data together with the County maintained datasets on an internet mapping system that is viewable by only local staff or in some cases the general public; and

WHEREAS an opportunity exists to leverage the current County web mapping system for a coordinated single source for mapping information and data; and

WHEREAS the County web mapping system can now be configured to allow hosting of local data that is viewable either by the general public or securely to designated local officials through a special login process as specified by the local governmental unit.




AUTHORIZE COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS WITH LOCAL UNITS OF GOVERNMENT FOR HOSTING SPATIAL DATA

This Ordinance authorizes the Parks and Land Use Department to enter into Memorandums of Understanding (MOU) with local units of government to host locally created and maintained data that can be linked to a mapping system (e.g. Road rights-of-way, utility data) together with County data on the County web mapping system. The standard MOU agreement responsibilities outlined will require the County to develop an interactive web mapping system displaying initial and periodic spatial data updates (as part of an outlined attachment to the agreement) of locally developed data set layers provided by the local government units.

The local government units will also identify custom reports and custom data queries that County Land Information Systems (LIS) staff will develop as part of the agreement. The County LIS staff will be responsible to develop an automated work flow for the uploading of updated local data sets into the web mapping system and provide appropriate password protected query access to their data in the system. In addition, local government units will coordinate with the County for expanded data, and reports.

According to the Parks and Land Use Director, the County will charge the local government units a one-time cost recovery charge for the actual costs associated with the initial implementation of a County hosted web mapping site including the development of an automated work flow for the uploading of the local units initial spatial data layers. This cost recovery charge is to include the actual costs to create and setup the mapping site, develop custom reports, custom queries, displays, and security options.

Also, annual cost recovery charges to local government units will be made by department management for on-going costs of system maintenance, data storage, upgrades, security, and requests for system alterations or additional custom reports and data queries to recover on-going costs being incurred.
