

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 170-80

TRANSFER JURISDICTION OF A PORTION OF COUNTY TRUNK  
HIGHWAY C TO THE CITY OF DELAFIELD

WHEREAS, Waukesha County owns and operates a county highway system, and

WHEREAS, Section 83.025(1), Wisconsin Statutes, permits a County Board to make deletions from the County Trunk Highway System with the approval of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (“WDOT”) and the governing body of the city, village or town in which the proposed deletion is located; and

WHEREAS, the County and the City of Delafield have negotiated a Jurisdictional Transfer Agreement covering a portion of Genesee Street (CTH C) for transfer from Waukesha County to the City of Delafield upon the completion of certain repairs to CTH C and the receipt of WDOT approval.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS that the Waukesha County Executive is authorized to execute the Jurisdictional Transfer Agreement deleting the portion of Genesee Street (CTH C) from Mill Street to the south limits of Oakwood Drive from the County Trunk Highway System and transferring jurisdiction thereof from Waukesha County to the City of Delafield, a copy of which is on file in the office of the County Clerk.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the County Department of Public Works is directed to take all necessary actions to implement the terms and conditions of said Agreement.

TRANSFER JURISDICTION OF A PORTION OF  
COUNTY TRUNK HIGHWAY C TO  
THE CITY OF DELAFIELD

This ordinance authorizes the execution of a jurisdictional transfer agreement of approximately 0.45 miles of County Trunk Highway (CTH) C (Genesee Street) from the County to the City of Delafield. The portion to be transferred will be from Mill Street to Oakwood Road. The agreement specifies that the transfer will take place on July 1, 2017.

As part of the agreement the County will first reconstruct/resurface this stretch of road, with the City sharing a portion of the cost for City-requested amenities (e.g., sidewalks, street lights, etc.). Work for this project is included in the current adopted five-year capital plan (capital project #201116) and expected to begin in 2016.

Upon transfer, the City will assume all costs related to maintenance, including signs, signals, pavement markings and snow/ice removal. This transfer is expected to favorably affect ongoing, levy-funded highway maintenance operations by marginally reducing costs for the 0.45-mile segment, although the impact is not expected to be large.

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
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

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
