Key Focus: Yard Waste Management/Composting

Reasoning and Goals: Because the Village has many homes built on larger lots, it stands to reason that education on yard waste management would be useful. The goal will be to reach every household with yard waste management at least once throughout the year and to have at least 10 people at the workshop.

Plan Elements:

- Educational workshop Sustainable Yardening: County will provide a workshop on managing yard waste and other sustainable practices at the Waukesha Library. County will promote the workshop through providing a display banner to the library prior to the workshop and inclusion in the public guide. Village will promote the workshop by posting the event on their website, at their building, and through signage/flyers at spring primaries and elections.
- 2. **Outreach:** County will provide a display with handouts for the spring elections.
- 3. Webpage information: County will create content for a website identifying the EPAs hierarchy of yard and food waste management and providing local resources for the management of organic items. Village will provide County terms of current yard waste program available to residents in the Village (i.e. curbside/drop off options as available) and will host the final webpage on the Village's website for the duration of the 3 year plan.
- 4. **Tax insert:** County will create a short paragraph with input from the Village for inclusion on the annual tax insert

Key Focus: Leaf Management

County will promote the workshop through providing a display banner to the library prior to the workshop. Village will promote the workshop by posting the event on their website, at their building, and at fall elections.
- 2. **Outreach:** County will provide a leaf management outreach display for the fall elections.
- 3. Webpage information: County will create content for a website identifying the EPAs hierarchy of yard and food waste management and providing local resources for the management of organic items. Village will provide County terms of current yard waste program available to residents in the Village (i.e. curbside/drop off options as available) and will host the final webpage on the Village's website for the duration of the 3 year plan.
