AMEND THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT 2015 BUDGET FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF NATIONAL DRUG CONTROL POLICY COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT FUNDS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT AND BROADCAST OF PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENTS

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Department has participated with the Office of National Drug Control Policy to support increased drug education, investigation, and enforcement in the Milwaukee High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA), and

WHEREAS, the Waukesha County Metropolitan Drug Enforcement Unit has developed a strong working partnership with Waukesha County Drug Free Communities which is an organization that works with school districts, parents, health-care workers, and law enforcement officers to reduce the supply of drugs in the community and educate the public about the consequences and realities of substance abuse, and

WHEREAS, Waukesha County Drug Free Communities has expressed an interest in partnering with Waukesha West High School to create public service announcements focused on encouraging positive choices and pursuing positive activities instead of turning to alcohol, marijuana, or prescription drug use for entertainment, and

WHEREAS, the public service announcements that are created will be shown to fellow high school students and in four Marcus theaters in Waukesha County over a twelve week period starting in June 2015, and

WHEREAS, the public service announcements are anticipated to be shown to approximately 384,000 movie attendees and 1,230 high school students, and

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee HIDTA has expressed an interest in providing \$11,250 from reprogrammed HIDTA funds to create and the broadcast those public service announcements.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS that the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department is authorized to accept High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area cooperative funding of \$11,250 from the Office of National Drug Control Policy to create and broadcast public service announcements in Marcus theaters.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department 2015 Budget is modified by increasing intergovernmental revenues by an additional \$11,250 and increasing the operating appropriation by \$11,250 for expenditures made in accordance with the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area funding authorization.
