WHEREAS, an employee of Waukesha County Department of Public Works has filed a Worker's Compensation claim against Waukesha County for injuries allegedly occurred while employed with Waukesha County, and

WHEREAS, the continuation of the litigation possesses substantial risk to both sides of the litigation and both sides will continue to incur significant additional expenses without a settlement, and


WHEREAS, the employee has expressed a willingness to enter into a settlement agreement which is on file in the Corporation Counsel's office pending approval by the County Board and which has been shared in closed session with the County Board, and
