DESIGNATION OF WAUKESHA COUNTY COMMUNICATION CENTER AS SINGLE  
PUBLIC SAFETY ANSWERING POINT (PSAP) IN COUNTY FOR WIS. STAT.  
SECTION 256.35(3s)(bm) GRANT ELIGIBILITY

WHEREAS, every municipal and state agency that provides fire suppression, law enforcement, and EMS, may establish a 911 system. Most counties operate their own Public Safety Answering Point ("PSAP") to meet the needs of their citizens; and

WHEREAS, the 2017-19 Wisconsin state budget required the Wisconsin Department of Military Affairs ("DMA") to create an emergency services IP network to be provided to all PSAPs. This digital network is essential in transitioning the state's 911 system from the old and outdated analog system to a current and advanced Next Generation 911 system; and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statute Section 256.35(3s)(bm)1. created a much needed PSAP grant program aimed to provide grant dollars for advanced training of telecommunicators; equipment or software expenses; and incentives to consolidate some or all of the functions of two or more PSAPs; and

WHEREAS, Section 256.35(3s)(bm)4. prohibits DMA from awarding grants under the program to more than one PSAP per county and rules promulgated under Chapter DMA 2 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code empowers the County Board by resolution to designate the single PSAP in the county eligible to apply for Section 256.35(3s)(bm) grants.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA RESOLVES that the Waukesha County Communications Center of the Waukesha County Department of Emergency Preparedness be designated as the single Public Safety Answering Point eligible to apply for and receive Wisconsin Statute Section 256.35(3s)(bm) grants.
