

Waukesha County Cropland Rental Bidding Process

August

An official public notice is posted in the Waukesha Freeman once weekly, over a two-week period. In addition, it is posted on the Land Resources Division (LRD) web page at <u>Waukesha County - Agriculture</u>. Complete the online bid form, print it and sign it, then submit it to Waukesha County as directed on the form. Sealed bids are due approximately two weeks after publication at the time stated in the notice. September

A public bid opening is held in the Waukesha County Administration Center, room 260. A summary of all the bids submitted is emailed to anyone that has submitted a bid. Any questions will be researched and resolved. The Waukesha County Department of Parks & Land Use reserves the right to reject any or all bids, or may accept the bid most advantageous to the County.

October

LRD staff will schedule an appointment with the potential lessee. At this meeting, we will review the <u>Waukesha County Cropland Conservation Standards</u>, review terms of the <u>lease</u>, and obtain a signature on the lease.

February

Invoices mailed for the one-third down payment for the annual rent due on or before March 1. A Certificate of Liability Insurance is also due at that time.
