

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 176-117

CREATE A PARKING REGULATION FOR CTH N IN THE TOWN OF EAGLE

WHEREAS the Department of Natural Resources has requested parking study along CTH N due to safety concerns for pedestrians and traffic on CTH N at the Paradise Springs Natural Trail; and

WHEREAS in response to this request, Waukesha County had a traffic report prepared documenting sight distance and shoulder width constraints that are not appropriate for safe parking at this location; and

WHEREAS the State of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources has alternative off-street parking available at this location; and

WHEREAS the parking, standing and stopping of vehicles along county trunk highways can have a detrimental effect upon highway capacity and safety; and

WHEREAS this prohibited parking area provides safe visibility of traffic conditions for motorists, and

WHEREAS Section 349.13 of the Wisconsin Statutes provides that local authorities may regulate the parking standing and stopping of vehicles along such highways.


THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES ORDAIN that the following parking regulation shall be in effect upon the placement of proper signs:


Both sides of CTH N from a point 575 feet North of the Paradise Springs Natural Trail access southerly to a point that is 925 feet South of the Paradise Springs Natural Trail access in the Town of Eagle – No Parking at Any Time.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance rescinds all other previous parking regulations for the above-described portion of the County Trunk Highway System.





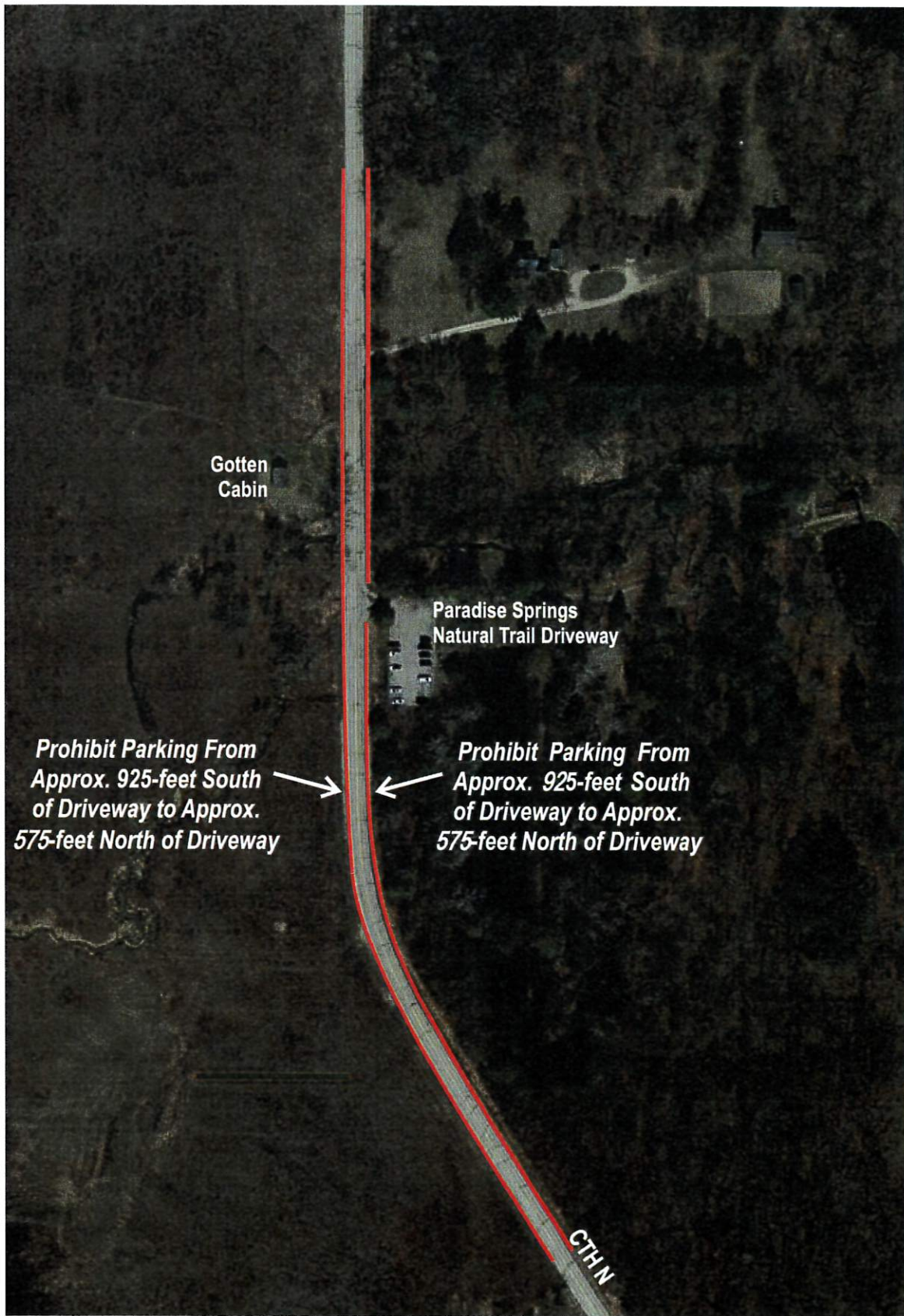
