GOLF COURSE SUPERINTENDENT

FUNCTION OF THE JOB

Under general supervision to direct and perform work in the development and maintenance of a golf course, and to perform other duties as required.

CHARACTERISTIC DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Plans, organizes, directs, and performs maintenance work at an assigned golf course.
- 2. Prepares detailed work programs and assigns personnel and equipment to work projects.
- 3. Checks work in progress and completed work.
- 4. Directs golf course maintenance personnel in the operation of all golf course equipment
- 5. Orients, trains and instructs employees in proper golf course maintenance activities and safety practices and procedures.
- 6. Instructs employees in the safe handling and application of chemicals and monitors for proper usage.
- 7. Instructs employees in and assures preventive maintenance of equipment, facilities, and grounds.
- 8. Diagnoses and prescribes proper treatment for turf, tree, and shrub diseases.
- 9. Inspects the facilities and projects to determine if golf course maintenance work is being done properly.
- 10. Maintains an inventory and requisitions materials, supplies, tools, and equipment.
- 11. Establishes and maintains effective working relationships with the staff and the public.
- 12. Provides information to the general public.
- 13. Keeps records and makes reports.
- 14. Performs other duties as required.

QUALIFICATIONS

Essential Knowledge and Abilities

- 1. Considerable knowledge of current methods of development, management and care of golf courses and related areas.
- 2. Considerable knowledge of the practices, procedures, tools, materials, and equipment used in golf course maintenance work.
- 3. Considerable knowledge of the operation and care of maintenance equipment and tools.
- 4. Working knowledge of fertilizers and turf, tree, and shrub diseases.
- 5. Ability to maintain and develop golf course properties and their facilities.
- 6. Ability to plan, organize, direct and perform golf course maintenance work.
- 7. Ability to train employees in duties, in chemical handling and in safety practices and procedures.
- 8. Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with the staff and the public.

QUALIFICATIONS

Essential Knowledge and Abilities (continued)

- 9. Ability to effectively interact with sensitivity with persons from diverse cultural, socioeconomic, educational, racial, ethnic, and professional backgrounds, and persons of all ages and lifestyles.
- 10. Ability to keep records and make reports.

Training and Experience

- 1. High school graduation or GED equivalent.
- 2. Five (5) years experience in the maintenance of a golf course or directly related work.
- 3. Recognized post high school training with specialization in park or golf course management, landscape architecture or a directly related field may be substituted on a year-for-year basis for up to four years of the required experience.
- 4. Prefer a certified golf course superintendent with certification through Golf Course Superintendents Association of America.
- 5. The following work assignments will require the possession of a valid Class 'A' Commercial Driver's License from the State of Wisconsin within twelve (12) months of date of hire.
 - a. Moor Downs Golf Course Superintendent.
