

Enrolled Ordinance 172-10

ACCEPT CASH DONATIONS FOR VETERANS SERVICES DIVISION AND MODIFY  
THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES 2017 BUDGET TO  
APPROPRIATE THE DONATIONS

WHEREAS, it is the mission of Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Veterans Services, to advocate for and assist all veterans of the U.S. Armed Services, their dependents, and survivors, and

WHEREAS, the Division of Veterans Services is committed to provide services in a courteous, effective and fiscally responsible manner and to maximize services available to its clients, and

WHEREAS, the Division of Veterans Services has received a \$5,000 donation from Fiserv, Inc., a \$145 donation from Eaton Corporation, Plc., and a \$500 donation from Thomas Tomatz, a veteran and local resident, to support Waukesha County veterans and the activities of the Division of Veterans Services, and

WHEREAS, the Division of Veterans Services will be hosting a Veterans Resource Fair at the Waukesha Expo Arena October 16<sup>th</sup> and October 17<sup>th</sup>, 2017, and

WHEREAS, the Division of Veterans Services will incur \$1,500 of costs related to hosting the Veterans Resource Fair that were not anticipated and were not included in the 2017 Veterans Services Division budget.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA  
ORDAINS that the cash donations provided to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Veterans Services and specified in this ordinance are accepted for the mission and activities of the Division of Veterans Services.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Veterans Services 2017 budget be modified by appropriating \$1,500 of operating expenses for hosting a Veterans Resource Fair and increasing other revenue by \$1,500.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the balance of the cash donations provided to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Veterans Services and accepted through this ordinance shall be committed for the exclusive use of the Division of Veterans Services until the donated funds are appropriated to Division activities through a future ordinance or budget.

FOR VETERANS SERVICES

This ordinance authorizes the Veterans Services Division of the Department of Health and Human Services to accept cash donations totaling \$5,645. This ordinance also modifies the 2017 Veterans Services budget by authorizing expenditure appropriation of \$1,500 in the operating expenses appropriation unit and increasing donation revenues by \$1,500. The funds will be used for costs associated with hosting a Veterans Resources Fair. The remaining \$4,145 will be committed for future use by the Veterans Services Division, subject to appropriation by the County Board.

This ordinance results in no impact to 2017 tax levy.
