March 29th, 2023

On Tuesday, March 28th, 2023, at 8:12PM, the Waukesha County Sheriff's Office was informed of a missing elderly adult who had walked away from Pick 'N Save located in the Village of Wales. Deputies began to search the area, as well as checking the home of the subject. A Silver Alert was issued for the 67-year-old female. The goal of a Silver Alert is for the general public to be aware of the missing person and be able to identify them if they see them.

A systematic search of the area was completed with the assistance of multiple fire departments and surrounding law enforcement agencies. On March 29<sup>th</sup>, 2023, at 8:41AM, the subject was found safe off the Glacial Drumin Trail at the bottom of a steep embankment. She was transported to a local hospital for weather exposure, and she was reunited with her family.

The Waukesha County Sheriff's Office was provided with resources from the City of Waukesha Police Department, Lake Country Fire Department, Merton Community Fire Department, Western Lakes Fire District, New Berlin Police Department, Muskego Police Department, and the Wisconsin Department of Justice.

We would like to thank the citizens and local businesses that were contacted during this investigation. Multiple citizens provided information to Waukesha County Communications Center about possible sightings of the subject.
