Fatal Crash in the City of Pewaukee

On Wednesday, June 26th, 2024, at 9:32 AM, a 49-year-old male was driving westbound on Capitol Dr., about 0.1 miles east of Pewaukee Rd. The truck rearended another vehicle traveling westbound on Capitol Dr., which was operated by a 76-year-old female. The female driver died from her injuries.

The truck continued westbound on Capitol Dr. and struck two construction workers at the intersection of Pewaukee Rd. A 47-year-old male construction worker received non-life-threatening injuries; a 46-year-old male construction worker was transported to a local hospital where he was pronounced deceased. The 49-year-old driver of the truck has non-life-threatening injuries.

The intersection of Capitol Dr. and Pewaukee Rd. is now open in all directions.

The cause of the crash remains under investigation. The Waukesha County Sheriff's Office was assisted by the Wisconsin State Patrol, the Village of Pewaukee Police Department, and the City of Pewaukee Fire Department.
